## Method and worked example(s) where appropriate

Learning support free school meal units are calculated by dividing the percentage of free school meals by 10 , add 1 and then multiply the result by the number of free school meals. For schools with part time nursery pupils the number eligible for free meals is assumed to be in proportion to full time pupil eligibility. For secondary schools, post 16 pupils are excluded.

Learning support and STAR KS1 units are a four year average calculated each year by adding the number of pupils at key stage 1and the number working towards level 1 , weighted by 3 , and then multiplying by the number of year groups at the school.
STAR free school meal units are calculated as for learning support but the number of part time nursery pupils added as free school meal entitlements is calculated by multiplying the number of part time nursery pupils by the number of free school meals and then dividing by 100 .
English as an Additional Language units are calculated with reference to an assessment of each pupils proficiency in English on a scale of 0 to 4,0 being the lowest score; a score of 0 is weighted by 5 , going down to no resource units for a score of 4 .

Learning support KS2 units are a three year average calculated each year by averagingthe number of pupils at level 3 or below in English or Mathematics.

## Method and worked example(s) where appropriate:

Lump sum - each primary school receives a lump sum which is tapered for each pupil in excess of 150 ; when the number of pupils exceeds 450 no lump sum is payable. For secondary schools the pupil number taper figures are 450 and 700 . For the three years following a school amalgamation the new school continues to receive lump sum payments as if it were two schools.
Admissions - payable, on a per pupil basis, to all schools responsible for the administration of pupil admissions.
School meals - actual free school meals provided during the period 1 January to 31 December 2005 are used as an estimate for the current year and to adjust the estimate made in the previous year.
Falling rolls - triggered when the number of funded pupils reduces by more than $5 \%$.
Pupil mobility - a pupil mobility percentage is derived by adding all pupil admissions and departures, excluding those at the beginning and end of academic years, dividing by 2 , expressed as a percentage of total pupils (nursery pupils are excluded entirely from the calculation). For schools with more than 550 pupils the first $5 \%$ are excluded when calculating the number of pupils used to calculate mobility; for other schools the first $7.5 \%$ are excluded.

Threshold pay - this former specific grant is moving towards allocation on a pupil number basis over a five year transitional period; for 2006/07 80\% of the allocation is based on a count of teachers on the Upper Pay Spine in October 2005 and $20 \%$ on the number of funded pupils. Each UPS1 receives a weighting of 1, UPS2 an additional 0.27 , and UPS3 0.28 . That part relating to sixth form pupils is met from the LSC and included above
