

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL
(CHICHESTER ROAD, SOUTHEND ON SEA)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)**

Notice is hereby given that the Southend-on-Sea City Council intends, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from; -

1. Entering Chichester Road from its junction with Tylers Avenue (north bound)
2. Entering Chichester Road from its junction with Warrior Square (south bund)

These works will be done in phases.

The closure is scheduled to commence from; -

1. Northbound closure will commence from 22:00 on the 18th of June 2024 till 06:00 on the 19th of June 2024
2. Southbound closure will commence from 22:00 on the 19th of June 2024 till 06:00 on the 20th of June 2024 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The alternative route will be via;-

1. **Northbound** - Tylers Avenue, Clifftown Road, Scratton Road, Cambridge Road, Trinity Avenue, Westcliff Parade, Westcliff Avenue, Milton Road, London Road & Queensway.
2. **Southbound** - Queensway or Chichester Road, Southchurch Road, Porters Grange roundabout, Queensway, Queensway & Chancellor Road roundabout, Chancellor Road, Church Road, Heygate Avenue & Chichester Road.

The Order will come into effect on 18th June 2024 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst Network rail undertake bridge maintenance takes place.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the **TRAFFIC SIGNS REGULATIONS AND GENERAL DIRECTIONS 2016**

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004
