Lump sum - each primary school receives a lump sum which is tapered for each pupil in excess of 150; when the number of pupils exceeds 450 no lump sum is payable. For secondary schools the pupil number taper figures are 450 and 700. For the three years following a school amalgamation the new school continues to receive lump sum payments as if it were two schools.

Nursery units are funded in multiples of 13 places with a minimum size of 15 places. The number of funded places is the actual number of pupils on January 2009 count day rounded up to the next multiple of 13. Where the number of places is not a multiple of 26, there is an additional allocation of £7,310.

Admissions - payable, on a per pupil basis, to all schools responsible for the administration of school admissions School meals - actual free school meals provided during the period 1 January to 31 December 2008 are used. Falling rolls - triggered when the number of funded pupils reduces by more than 5% of the previous years protected level. Where a school also receives funding from the KS1 class size factor the amount paid through falling rolls is reduced by that amount.

Pupil mobility - a pupil mobility percentage is derived by adding all pupil admissions and departures, excluding those at the beginning and end of academic years, dividing by 2, expressed as a percentage of total pupils (nursery pupils are excluded entirely from the calculation). For schools with more than 550 pupils the first 5% are excluded when calculating the number of pupils used to calculate mobility; for other schools the first 7.5% are excluded. Threshold pay - this former specific grant is moving towards allocation on a pupil number basis over a 5 year transitional period; for 2009-10 20% of the allocation is based on a count of teachers on the Upper Pay Spine in the Autumn Term 2008 and 80% on the number of funded pupils.
