From 1st April 2014 residents from outside the Borough of Southend-on-Sea will no longer be able to use Stock Road or Leigh-on-Sea Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRCs).

Why is this being introduced?

Essex County Council previously had an agreement with Southendon-Sea Borough Council that allowed non-Southend residents to utilise Stock Road HWRC. However, Essex County Council have decided to terminate the agreement from the 1st April 2014. As a result non-Southend residents can no longer be given access to Southend-on-Sea Borough Council's HWRCs after 31st March 2014.

Who will be affected by the change?

Anyone who does not reside in the Borough of Southend-on-Sea

(i.e. they don't pay Council Tax to Southend-on-Sea Borough Council) will be affected and can no longer use the HWRC sites. This will affect all Rochford District Council residents.
