



2011 CENSUS INFORMATION BRIEFING – 12th December 2012

The Office for National Statistics released on 11th December the first element of detailed population data estimates from the 2011 Census at local authority level. This release includes the following elements:

- Ethnicity
- Religion
- Household Language
- Health
- Economic Activity
- Tenure
- Dwelling Type
- Living Arrangements

Further releases are due:

- 30th January – Key statistics at sub-ward, ward and parliamentary constituency.
- Further analysis is due to be released on a rolling programme between February 2013 and October 2013
