1. Statement of Policies and Responsibilities

1.1 Policies and objectives

- 1.1.1 The Council as a unitary authority has a statutory obligation under Section 41 of Highways Act 1980 to maintain the highway. The introduction of new legislation (Railways and Transport Safety Act 2003) extended the requirements of Section 41 of the Highways Act 1980 to place a duty on a highway authority to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, that safe passage along a highway is not endangered by snow or ice.
- 1.1.2 The aim of The Winter Service Plan is to set out how the Winter Service is provided by Southend Borough Council
- 1.1.3 The Council aims is to provide an effective and efficient winter service to allow;
 - the safe passage of vehicles and pedestrians on priority routes
 - to control delays due to winter weather
 - to carry out essential services safely
- 1.1.4 The strategy adopted for Southend has been developed in accordance with the recommendations set within:-
 - The Code of Practice "Delivering Best Value in Highway Maintenance" published in July 2001 again in July 2005 then updated in September 2013. This document is available from the Department of Transport via www.dft.gov.uk
- 1.1.5 The Council's Contractor provide winter operational services. This generally involves spreading rock salt onto the surface of roads and footways by using purpose-built vehicles and hand operated machines.
- 1.1.6 Given the scale of financial and other resources involved in delivering the Winter service it is not practically possible to:
 - provide the service on all parts of the road and footway network
 - ensure surfaces of roads and footways are kept free of ice or snow at all times, even on the treated parts of the network
 - treat residential highways and footpaths
- 1.1.7 With the above in mind Southend Borough Council has developed policies and operational plans in consultation with stakeholders which have identified which routes should be included in a programme of treatment during inclement weather. In this context the following issues have been considered:
 - treatment for priority highways
 - treatment of facilities for priority shopping areas
 - treatment of facilities for public transport users
 - treatment of transport interchanges
 - extent of priority for emergency and other key facilities
 - extent of priority for potentially vulnerable users
 - other local circumstances

- 1.1.8 Southend Borough Council will ensure that gritting routes are widely known and understood especially by users, together with advice on safe use of the network. Performance during operational delivery will be monitored to respond effectively to changing conditions or network incidents.
- 1.1.9 The original version of this plan was approved at Planning & Transportation Committee 27th October 1998 Minute 478

1.2 Council Responsibilities

- 1.2.1 The management of the winter service falls within the Directorate of PLACE
- 1.2.2 The responsibilities of PLACE are to;
 - Deliver a service to deal with an average winter but having the capability to be extended to handle more severe winters.
 - Update the Winter Service Plan each year following a review of all operational aspects (see Appendix 1 for annual changes)
 - Liaising with adjoining authorities to ensure that the Winter service Plan is continuous at the boundaries;
 - Providing a list of pre-treatment salting routes for carriageways, footways, and cycle ways for different winter weather conditions.
 - Providing a list of routes for post treatment during prolonged extreme or severe weather conditions.
 - Arranging for adequate weather forecasts during the winter period.
 - Providing a location list of salt and sand bins.
 - Monitoring the salt usage and ensuring that new supplies are ordered and delivered to maintain an appropriate level of salt.
 - Establishing communication networks to allow immediate contact between the Councils Representative and the contractor, and the Council's emergency control room.

1.3 Contractor Responsibilities

1.3.1 The delivery of winter service operations is the responsibility of the Council's Recycling, Waste and Street Cleansing Contractor.

Their responsibilities are to,

- Decide on when to carry out operations
- Provide and maintain vehicles and resources adequate to carry out the salting of all routes (highway and pedestrian) within the specified response times.
- Provide skilled mechanical salting vehicle drivers, weighbridge operators, shovel drivers, supervisors, etc. adequate to manage and complete the winter service operations to the specification within the response times.
- Establishing communication networks to allow immediate contact between The contractor supervisor/manager and the Council's Representative/winter maintenance manager and Customer Service Centre: The contractor's supervisor/manager and his drivers, workshop operatives, shovel driver and fitter.
- Providing accurate information on the service completed such as estimated weights if appropriate of salt usage, recording of response and treatment times.
- Ensuring that all operatives are appropriately trained in winter service operations

- To ensure that workshop facilities and appropriate skilled personnel are available on 24 hour call-out during the winter period to repair and maintain vehicles and to deal with any mechanical breakdowns that may occur.
- Providing the Council with regular and timely information on plant condition, listing any mechanical faults which would prevent satisfactory operation.
- Recording and logging in writing all decisions relating to the winter service, supplying this information to nominees made by the Council at an agreed time before operations commence

1.4 Decision making process and responsibilities

- 1.4.1 The Contractor will trigger operations for road service and footway treatment after consulting and scrutinising information from a Winter Forecast Service, supplied by Roadcast Meteogroup.. Weather information is also available from the Meteorological Office.
- 1.4.2 The Contractor shall receive and assess the weather forecast and should this forecast predict changeable or marginal conditions then clarification can be sought from the consultant forecaster or the Council's Representative. Weather updates are received 3 times a day. It is often the case that a decision whether service will be required can only be made once all updates have been reviewed on a particular day. Refer to Appendix 2 Decision Making Matrix Guide which tabulates the actions and factors to be considered when making a decision.
- 1.4.3 It is crucial to arrive at a decision, which does not compromise risk but does not lead to unnecessary operations being undertaken.
- 1.4.4 A 'Daily Decision –works completion' proforma is completed on a daily basis or no later than 9am the following morning. This form and the individual gritting reports must be filled out by the Winter Service Contractor. (see Appendix 3).
- 1.4.5 Pre- treatment salting to designated carriageways would be carried out if the forecast indicates:
 - Ice/ hoar frost or snow conditions.
- 1.4.6 Post treatment salting to designated carriageways would be carried out when the conditions are:
 - Extreme and severe and predicted to last for a prolonged period.
- 1.4.7 Selective pre-treatment route salting to designated footways would be carried out should the forecast indicate:
 - Extreme and severe weather conditions predicted to last for a prolonged period.
- 1.4.8 Snow clearing (manual shoveling and use of quad bikes with ploughs) of priority pavements would normally be carried out after periods of heavy settled snow occurred.
- 1.4.9 Snow ploughing of priority roads is carried out to remove settled snow once gritting is ineffective and deep settled snow persists.

2 Quality

2.1 Document control procedures

- 2.1.1 All information collated and recorded during the winter service period is held electronically by the Contractor. Information will include the following;
 - Copy of orders requesting service.
 - Contractors service returns recording, route number, vehicle registration number, drivers name, date, start kilometres, finish kilometres, start time of mobilisation, start time of treatment, finish time of treatment, vehicle weights in and out, (loaded and unloaded), weight of surplus salt, weighbridge times and any vehicle/plant faults.
 - The Winter Service Plan is held by the Group Manager for Waste and Environmental Care, and, appropriate Officers within the Waste and Environmental Care Group and other Council Departments.

2.2 Circulation of document

- 2.2.1 The Winter Service Plan is an internal document, and key information is taken from this document and issued as follows;
 - Southend Borough Council website and Intranet

All other interested stakeholders will be informed that key elements of the Winter Service Plan is available on the website.

2.3 Performance Monitoring

2.3.1 A vehicle tracking system is in place to check the performance of the Contractor's winter maintenance service. This performance will be checked against the contract specifications. Regular reports can be downloaded from the tracker system and issues of concern raised at the appropriate Contractor's meeting.

The Council shall be satisfied that:

- Operations are within the specified periods for response and treatment;
- all roads/footways within routes have been treated;
- the specified spread rate has been adhered to;
- the Contractors equipment is in good working order;
- salt use and reserves are monitored and replenished as appropriate;
- the appropriate monitoring forms have been completed by the contractor

3. Operational Delivery of the Winter Service

Depending on weather conditions the following Operational Plans for the treatment of Priority Carriageways and Priority Footways will be initiated.

3.1 Carriageway routes for treatment

Routes (1A, 2A, 3A and 4A) - primary carriageway treatment

- 3.1.1 There are 4 main routes (1A to 4A) 'Primary Routes' that cover the major roads, bus routes, selected other busy roads, and selected hills on secondary and minor roads within Southend. (see Appendix 4) These routes would be treated for pre and post-treatment of snow and ice conditions. These primary routes are of the highest priority and will be actioned first before any footway treatment. Two additional gritter trailer routes may be used if heavy snow is expected. These will be deployed using 4x4 vehicles.
- 3.1.2 Emergency routes 2A, 2B and 2C have been developed which covers a reduced network to be utilised when salt reserves are to be maintained in light of national salt shortages. (see appendix 5) These routes will replace 1A to 4A during the emergency period. This part of the plan will be mobilised following agreement by the Council Winter Silver Command Emergency Group. These emergency routes are of the highest priority and will be actioned before any footway treatment
- 3.1.3 Each year in consultation with the Highways and Traffic Management Service routes will be updated as necessary due to new constraints imposed on access through, e.g. traffic calming measures or parking problems. Any amendments will be provided to the Contractor as soon as possible.

3.2 Ad hoc treatment

3.2.1 Vehicles maybe diverted during periods of snow and widespread ice at the request of the police or other emergency services

3.3 Snow ploughing treatment operations

3.3.1 The gritting vehicles can be fitted with snow ploughs and should snow ploughing be required the routes 1A to 4A will be followed (Appendix 4 details roads which should not be ploughed due to the highway infrastructure). The contractor with the consent of the Council's Representative may decide that a snow blower shall be mobilised to assist with snow clearing. See Appendix 6 for current contact details for snow blower.

3.4 Routes for footway treatment.

D2 & D3 primary footway treatment. Manual Salting and snow shoveling – Quad Routes A, 1,2 & 3,.

3.4.1 There are a number of footway locations which include; shopping areas, footbridges, subways and bus stops that will be treated as part of that days normal street cleansing

programme during inclement weather conditions. During periods of heavy snow, the contractor will shovel snow to create a path at least one meter wide to allow pedestrian to pass over the pavements. Some priority cycle paths are cleared.

Footbridges are sanded utilising near by sand bins to protect the integrity of the structures.

Routes D2 and D3 shall be carried out for pre-snow conditions, but may be triggered for other inclement weather conditions.

Quad routes A, 1,2,3 shall be carried out according to weather conditions and shall take place when road treatment operations have been instructed to take place.

Resources from waste collection (if services are suspended) may be utilised to support operations and directed onto clearing access ways to doctors sugeries and schools included in Appendix 11.

See Appendix 7 for weekday footway operations

See Appendix 8 for weekend footway operations

See Appendix 9 for a list of footbridges

See Appendix 10 for a list sand bins

A list of pedestrian crossing sites references are listed in Appendix 17 and should be treated when operation cover D2 and D3.

- 3.4.2 A requirement within the Waste Collection and Street Cleansing Contract is for the workforce to be employed on snow treatment when conditions dictate. Routine street cleansing and Waste Collection maybe suspended.
- 3.4.3 Three quads with gritting trailer and ploughs compliment manual clearance. High footfall areas and ad-hoc pedestrian locations are managed through quad clearance and/or gritting activities

3.5 Additional Footway and vulnerable locations

3.5.1 Once plans D2 and D3 have been completed the contrator will treat footway areas around schools, doctors surgeries and other vulnerable locations. These locations are listed in Appendix 11. Resources may be utilised from other contract sources to deliver this part of the plan. A separate list of contact information for schools and crossing sites is listed in Appendix 12 for information.

3.6 Treatment of Car parks

3.6.1 A list of car parks (including parking bays and vehicle routes) to be treated is in Appendix 13. This treatment shall be carried out following the treatment of priority roads, early in the morning before customers park their vehicles.

Staff Car Parks at the Central Library Car Park, Great Eastern Avenue, and the Civic Centre north car park (adjacent to Carnarvon Road, including entrance, exit and ramp to underground car park) should be treated with 'Urea'.

3.7 Response times for treatment and snow clearing.


3.7.1 The mobilisation time by the contractor for all operations will be within one hour.

3.8 Location and maintenance of salt bins

3.8.1 Salt storage bins are located on the highway across the Borough at potential problem locations. The bins are available for residents to use on areas of the public highway only. A list of these is shown in Appendix 14.

Residents are also able to purchase rock salt at a reasonable charge from the central depot in 20kg bags from Central Depot.

3.9 Summary of operational route hierarchy



Please note non priority residential carriageways and footpaths are not treated

4. Weather Prediction and Information

4.1 Forecasting, inspections and other decision support information

- 4.1.1 Southend subscribes to the Meteogroup weather measurement service which provides forecasting reports via the Meteogroup. The service is also used by Essex County Council
 - 4.1.2 The Meteogroup provide a 24hour telephone number 0845 603 0563 to speak to a forecaster to support the 'Decision Making' process. An example of a weather report is detailed in Appendix 15. Southend falls within the Thames Domain.

4.2 Timing

4.2.1 The forecasts are updated at approximately 07:00 hrs, at 13:00hrs and 1800hrs.

4.03 Other Information

- 4.3.1 The Meteorological Office sends out severe weather warning and updates to key operational staff which includes Southend's Emergency Planning Officer to inform any decision making process.
- 4.3.2 Locations in appendix 16 are prone to frost and road condition checks may be carried out to inform operational conditions.

6. Organisational Arrangements and Personnel

6.1 Employee duty schedules, rotas and standby arrangements

6.1.1 The contractor shall provide employee duty schedules, rotas and standby arrangements to the Council two weeks before the start of the winter period.

6.2 Plant and vehicle manning arrangements

6.2.1 The Contractor will ensure that adequate manning and standby requirements are in place to carry out the service to the specification.

6.3 Schedules of contractors to support extreme weather operations.

- The following Contractors may be called upon to provide back up during extreme conditions.
- Highways Contractors
- Park and Leisure Contractors
- Other service contractors

6.4 Training and development arrangements

6.4.1 The Contractor shall ensure that all drivers of the Salt Spreading Vehicles shall have received proper training and instruction in the safe and efficient operation of the vehicles and their equipment.

6.5. Health and safety procedures

6.5.1 The contractor will provide risk and COSHH assessments for materials and for operations and explain the significance of these to all operatives. Appropriate PPP equipment will be issued to all staff prior to the start of the winter season.

7. Plant, Vehicles and Equipment

7.1 Fleet inventory

- 7.1.1 Prior to the commencement of the winter period the contractor will supply to Waste and Environmental Care a detailed fleet inventory.
- 7.1.2 The current vehicles/plant provided is as follows;
 - 5 No. 6 tonne capacity purpose-built spreaders with trackers
 - 4 No. 1 tonne purpose-built trailer pickup spreader on a 4 tonne LDV vehicle.
 - 10 No. LDV 'caged' vehicles.
 - 1 No. Mechanical Loading shovel.
 - 1 No Snow Blower
 - 8 No. 75Kg capacity hand operated salt spreader

Additional equipment

No Quads with ploughs and trailers

7.2 Location of plant, vehicles and other equipment

7.2.1 The Contractor - will operate from Council owned depots where vehicles and plant will be stored and maintained.

7.3 Garaging, servicing and maintenance arrangements

7.3.1 The vehicles shall be stored and maintained in an efficient and workable condition to ensure reliable starting and use/performance. They shall be available for inspection by the WSS at all reasonable times without notice.

7.4 Contact and hire arrangements for contract plant

7.4.1 Not applicable

7.5 Calibration procedures

7.5.1 The calibration of the salt spreading equipment shall be in accordance with BS 1622.

8. Salt and De-Icing Materials

8.1 Location and capacity of stocks for salt and other materials

8.1.1 The minimum stockpile at the beginning of the Winter Maintenance Period, will be 2000 tonnes, stored at Stock Road. Responsibly for ordering supplies will be with WEC.

8.2 Supply

- 8.2.1 The salt that is used on highways during winter is a naturally occurring rock salt, and shall be to the requirements of BS 3247 'Salt for Spreading Coarse Rock Salt' (6mm particle size).
- 8.2.2 The 'Safecote' additive is an engineered 'bi product' of sugar processing and has been widely used.

8.3 Delivery arrangements

8.3.1 The Contractor shall provide the necessary mechanical loading shovel, other plant and labour to off load and stack the salt. Restocking will normally take place outside the Winter Maintenance period but may be at any time

8.4 Treatment requirements including spread rates

8.4.1 The variable nature of winter conditions make it difficult to define exact treatments and salt applications. Guidance on appropriate spread rates is given below:

For pre-treatment salting

- 7.5gms/m2 is the normal rate;
- 15 gms/m2 if freezing conditions are expected after rain;
- 20 to 40 gms/m2 if continuous snow is forecast according to the anticipated severity of the snowfall.

For treatment of settled snow/ice:

- 20 to 40gms/m2 for ice depending on the amount and temperature;
- 20 to 40 gms/m2 for moderate snowfalls;
- 40gms/m2 for prolonged snowfalls and ploughing as required
- Successive treatments of 20 to 40gms/m2 for hard packed snow/ice

8.5 Contacts and purchasing arrangements for supplies

- 8.5.1 The Council will purchase rock salt from:
 - Salt Union Limited, Winsford Rock Salt Mine, Bradford Road, Winsford, Cheshire, CW7 2PE, 01606 861 850 – or other suppliers following procurements.

9. Operational Communications

9.1 Technical systems information

- 9.1.1 It is important that good communications are maintained during the winter period to ensure that the response to poor conditions is effective and immediate.
- 9.1.2 At all times the contractors supervisor should be available by mobile phone.
- 9.1.3 During normal working hours the Councils Representative will be available by by phone or via the Back office Data Management system. The Contractor shall be able to receive instructions by phone, and any Data Management System as nominated by the Council.
- 9.1.4 The Council's Out of Hours Service will handle calls outside normal working hours as pass queries to the Contractor as appropriate.
- 9.1.5 During severe periods of weather (snow and widespread ice) problem areas may be notified to the Contractor by phone calls received from the Police and members of the public via the Customer Service Centre. The Contrator shall log these calls and the approproiate action taken.

10. Information and Publicity

10.1 Local press and broadcast contact information

- The Contractor to provide an operational brief by e mail to a list of recipients as nominated by the Council on daily basis before operations commence.
- A Daily bulletin may be issued by the Media Team during periods of extreme winter weather to provide information and guidance.
- The Council's Customer Service Centre will be updated daily with information and guidance that may be provided to customers.
- The Councils Website will be updated accordingly

10.2 Other contact information

10.2.1 The Media Team will liaise with transport operators and emergency services to update as necessary.

Appendix 1 Summary of previous amendments to Winter Service Plan

- 1. Changes included for delivery 13/14
 - a. Two gritters at end of life, two have been hired to replace
 - b. Well Maintained Highways Code of Practice (amended Sept 13) released and reviewed taking account of grit rate settings and spread rates aligned accordingly
- 2. Changes included for delivery 2012/13
 - a. Well Maintained Highways Code of Practice reviewed and Winter Service Plan complies with this Code
 - b. High Street Quad route developed for Frost operations
 - c. Three pedestrian quad routes devised for snow and ongoing severe weather
 - d. Amendment to gritting route to include development of Southend Airport highway infrastructure
 - e. Basic recording system set up on Contender for inputting daily decision making on operations to be used by Environmental Care Officers
- 3. Changes included for delivery 2011/12
 - a. Three quad bikes with ploughs and gritting trailers purchased and used for clearance of snow and gritting of pedestrian areas in severe weather. Three pedestrian quad routes devised from existing pedestrian clearance routes. Salt stockpiles established for ease of refilling
 - b. Salt Stocks increased from 1600tonnes to 2000tonnes
- 2. Changes included for delivery in 2010/11
 - Each year the Winter Maintenance Plan is updated to take account of changes that are needed to ensure that the Winter Maintenance Service continues to operate in an efficient way. Since last year the following changes have been made to the Plan.
 - a. Use of the term "Winter Service" instead of Winter "Maintenance" as adopted by Well-maintained Highways Code of Practice for Highway Maintenance July 2005
 - b. Daily management of the service now rests with the Service Manager (Team Leader Environmental Care) and the Senior Environmental Care Officer
 - c. Liaison for Contract Requirements is with the Service Manager (Team Leader Waste) with responsibility for the street cleansing contract
 - d. Copies of the priority Gritting Routes are now available on the Councils website at www.southend.gov.uk
 - e. Revised Priority gritting routes agreed when national salt reserves are in place.
 - f. Two new 6 tonne capacity gritters purchased, also used in 09/10 service. Two new gritting trailers purchased.
- 3. Changes included for delivery in 2009/10
 - a. There have been changes to the Directorate of Enterprise, Tourism and the Environment and the responsibilities for co-ordination of the Winter Maintenance Plan now fall under both the Head of Public Protection and the Head of Planning and Transport. However the lead role rests with the Head of Public Protection.
 - b. A new Waste Management Contract has been awarded from 29/9/08 which includes lead responsibility for activating this plan.

- c. The development of the new Contact Service Centre will change the process of how winter maintenance enquiries are managed.
- d. The main service provider remains as Cory Environmental with greater emphasis on service management.
- e. The Met Office updates are regularly reviewed and incorporated as part of the Essex Consortium for this purpose.

The decision to undertake precautionary treatments should, if appropriate, be adjusted to take account of residual salt or surface moisture.

All decisions require continuous monitoring and review.

Notes

- a. Particular attention should be given to the possibility of water running across or ponding on carriageways and other running surfaces e.g. off adjacent fields after heavy rains, washing off or diluting salt previously deposited. Such locations should be closely monitored and may require treating in the evening and morning and possible other occasions. See Warning 6.
- b. When a weather warning contains reference to expected hoarfrost, considerable deposits of frost may occur. Hoarfrost usually occurs in the early morning and is difficult to cater for because of the probability that any salt deposited on a dry road too soon before its onset, may be dispersed before it can become effective. Close monitoring is required under this forecast condition which should ideally be treated just as the hoarfrost is forming. Such action is usually not practicable and salt may have to be deposited on a dry road prior to and as close as possible to the expected time of the condition. Hoarfrost

- may be forecast at other times in which case the timing of salting operations should be adjusted accordingly.
- c. If, under these conditions, rain has not ceased by early morning, crews should be called out and action initiated as rain ceases.
- d. Under these circumstances rain will freeze on contact with running surfaces and full pretreatment should be provided even on dry roads. This is a most serious condition and should be monitored closely and continuously throughout the danger period. Authorities should be aware of the health safety implications of ice forming during freezing rain events, both to the travelling public and winter maintenance personnel carrying out treatments. They should be prepared to make follow up treatments on any ice that has formed or to take suitable actions such as road closures.
- e. By using domain-based forecasting, consideration can be given to differing actions from each depot.
- f. Where there is any hint of moisture being present, a pessimistic view of the forecast should be taken when considering treatment to negatively textured surfaces. See Warning 6
- g. Spreading salt alone at temperatures below about -7°C (the lower of air or road surface at time of spreading) or below about -5°C in low humidity conditions (relative humidity less than 80%) may not be practically effective. High spread rates will be required and even then salt may not enter solution quickly enough to prevent freezing or be able to melt ice or compacted snow. Consideration should be given to spreading at least 2 hours before the temperature reaches these values to allow salt to enter solution, or the use of alternative de-icers.

Warning 6

Weather and road surface conditions:

• A very significant quantity of salt is required to prevent freezing if water has ponded on or is flowing across a road surface. Spreaders can be operated in blast mode, but this is often insufficient to prevent freezing. N.B. Approx. 100g/m² of rock salt is required to prevent the freezing of water of depth 2.5mm (or 1kg/m² for 25mm of ponded water) at road surface temperatures down to only -2°C. Where water is flowing onto the carriageway (or up through porous surfacing, cracks, etc.) it will remove the salt solution. Thus spreading at high rates or in blast mode may be ineffective no matter how much salt is spread.


