NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Southend-on-Sea Borough Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 36, 45,46,46A,47, 49, 53 and 124 (and part IV of Schedule 9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance to Part III of Schedule 9 to the act of 1984 as amended by Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004.

The general effect of the Order would be the introduction of shared permit parking places and pay and display/pay by phone parking to facilitate the improvement of parking for residents and visitors in the following roads, between the hours of 11am to 9 pm daily; and minor amendments to the preamble and schedules of the order. The following Map Tiles Nos. U16, U17, V16 & V17 will be updated
