

Disability Related Expenditure

This form is about extra money that you have to spend because you have a disability and can't do everything for yourself or can't easily use public transport. We call it Disability Related Expenditure.

Examples of things that you may have to pay for:

- clothes or continence items
- taxi fares
- someone to do things for you such as shopping or laundry
- help with housework or gardening
- chiropody



You may have bought or are renting equipment to help you because of your disability.

If you tell us about these kinds of expenses, we may be able to take account of them when we work out how much you will have to pay for services we provide. We already ask you about your income and capital and if we know what you spend because of your disability, it may reduce what you have to pay for our services.

If you are not sure whether or not to inform us about an expense, please tell us and we will advise you.
