

**THE BOROUGH OF SOUTHEND-ON-SEA  
(LONDON ROAD, SOUTHEND-ON-SEA)  
(RESTRICTED PARKING ZONE) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2019**

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Southend-on-Sea Borough Council, acting as the local highway authority, made an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will prohibit waiting except for waiting in the marked and signed bays in the sections of roads described in the Schedule below and shown on Map Tile No T17

The Experimental Order shall come into operation on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2019 .and shall remain in force until 19<sup>th</sup> July 2020, during which time the Council will monitor the scheme and consider representations made to it before deciding whether or not to introduce a permanent scheme.

A copy of the Experimental Order, together with a map showing the road to which the Experimental Order relates and the statement of reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the Contact Centre on the ground floor of the Civic Centre (address below) during normal office hours.

Within a period of six months from the Experimental Order coming into force, or if that order is subsequently varied by another order under that Section or modified pursuant to sub-section 2 of Section 10 of the Act, from the coming into operation of that variation or modification (whichever is the latest), any person may object to the making of an order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation. Objections to the provisions of this Experimental Order being made permanent, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to **Deputy Chief Executive (Place) and marked for the attention of the Traffic Management & Road Safety Team at the address below by no later than 26<sup>th</sup> August 2019**

All written representations received concerning traffic regulation orders are public documents that may be inspected by any person on demand.
