

**THE SOUTHEND-ON-SEA BOROUGH COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS, PARKING PLACES AND PERMIT PARKING ZONES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2016 (AMENDMENT NO.10) ORDER 2019  
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Southend-on-Sea Borough Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, and 124 (and part IV of Schedule 9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance to Part III of Schedule 9 to the act of 1984 as amended by Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 the effect of which will amend the above-mentioned Consolidation Order by the adding of the items listed below and the updating of Map Tile Schedules **V27**.

**To introduce Limited Waiting 20 mins No Return in 2 Hrs Daily on the following length of Road**

File Ref	Road	Side of Road	Proposed Description
125	Ness Road	East	From a point 12m north west of the north west kerbline of Maya Close to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos 19 and 21 Ness Road

**To introduce No Loading at Anytime on the following lengths of Road**

File Ref	Road	Side of Road	Proposed Description
125	Ness Road	East	From the north west kerbline of Maya Close north westwards for a distance of 12m
	Ness Road	East	From the south east kerbline of Maya Close south eastwards for a distance of 15m
