The Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 The Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004 Consultation on the draft Scoping Report of the South Essex Joint Strategic Plan Integrated Impact Assessment

The six Local Authorities in South Essex (Basildon, Brentwood, Castle Point, Rochford, Southend and Thurrock) together with Essex County Council are currently working together across local authority boundaries on strategic issues related to planning and growth to ensure there are quality homes, jobs, transport and infrastructure and environment for its residents. This collaboration includes the preparation of a South Essex Joint Strategic Plan (the "South Essex Plan") that will set out a strategic framework for development in the area for the period up to 2038 and will reflect a broader vision to 2050. The South Essex Plan is at an early stage of preparation including evidence gathering and has not yet been subject to public consultation under Regulation 18.

The South Essex authorities have commissioned consultants to undertake an Integrated Impact Assessment (IIA) of the South Essex Plan, combining Sustainability Appraisal (SA) and Health Impact Assessment (HIA). A draft Scoping Report of the South Essex Plan IIA has now been prepared. In accordance with requirements of the Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004, as a consultation body, you are being consulted on the draft Scoping Report of the South Essex Plan Integrated Impact Assessment.
