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59	<p>Frequently Asked Questions</p> <p>If I want my child to take the 11+ test how do I do this?</p> <p>Your child's primary school will be able to advise you about the 11+ test and will provide you with relevant information about the entry process. Children take the test in September of Year 6 and parents/carers receive the results before the end of the application period so that all parents/carers can make an informed choice for their child. Children take the test in November of Year 6 and parents/carers will not receive the results before the end of the application period. We therefore recommend that you use all six preferences and ensure you have both selective and non-selective schools in your preferences.
