# **Adoption Statement**

In accordance with Regulations 24(4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is hereby given that Southend on Sea Borough Council ("the Council") formally adopted its Local Development Framework: Core Strategy Development Plan Document (CSDPD) on 13<sup>th</sup> December 2007.

The CSDPD forms part of the Southend on Sea Local Development Framework and provides the vision, objectives and planning strategy for the spatial development of the whole Borough of Southend-on-Sea until 2021, including the distribution of growth and the policy context for a 10 year housing supply. It also sets out the key policies against which all planning applications will be assessed, and the Council's core policies on matters such as transport, retail, employment, open space, minerals and the protection and enhancement of the natural and historic environment, including conservation areas.

The adopted CSDPD comprises the "Submission CSDPD" amended in accordance with the Inspectors' binding report of the Examination into the CCDPD, received by the Council on  $4^{th}$  October 2007.

Any person aggrieved by the CSDPD may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the ground that either the document is not within the power conferred by Part 2 of the Act or that a procedural requirement of the Act or its associated Regulations has not been complied with. Any application must be made no later than 6 weeks after the date of adoption specified above.

In addition, any person aggrieved by the CSDPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the CSDPD, and any such application must be made promptly and in any event no later than 3 months after the date of adoption specified above.
