ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Made: 12th September 2022

Coming into force: 12th September 2022

Southend-on-Sea City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as amended) ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Essex Police hereby make the following order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on and may be cited as "The Southend -on-Sea City Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No*) Order 2022 (PTO1034 Phase 1).
- 2. "The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2021 (PTO1005)" (the 2021 Order) is amended as follows.

Amendments

- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to the liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the 2021 Order and shall have effect:
 - a) the items represented on the plans in Schedule 1 to this Order shall replace those plans as listed in the appropriate Schedule to the 2021 Order.

The purpose of the proposals is to:-

- a) To introduce junction protection (no waiting at any time and no loading at any time restrictions in Shoeburyness Ward at the required junctions to improve safety. This is part of the City wide project.
- b) To amend the existing restrictions (no waiting at any time restrictions) to no waiting at any time and no stopping at any time restrictions in Shoeburyness Ward at the required junctions. This is also part of the City wide project.

Statement of Reasons for

Proposals: No Waiting at Any Time and No Loading at Any Time restrictions at the required junctions in Leigh Ward

a) To ensure the highest level of safety at each junction across the city of Southend; achieving this by maximising visibility and access for emergency vehicles.
