**THE SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL (WAITING, LOADING, STOPPING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) (AMMENDMENT NO.2) ORDER 2023  
PTO1039-5097 – Hampton Gardens (Bend)**

Southend-on-Sea City Council on **17 January 2023** made the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (as amended) proposes to make the following Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended):

1. **To introduce** No Waiting at Any Times restrictions (double yellow lines) on the South side of the road, on bend of Hampton Gardens; from the common boundary No.80 & No.82 to the common boundary of No.94 & No.96.  
**To extend** the existing No Waiting at Any Time restrictions (double yellow lines) on the North side of the road, on the bend of Hampton Gardens, in the northern direction, to opposite the common boundary of No.94 & No.96.
2. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 17 January 2023 and all relevant documents can also be viewed online at [www.southend.gov.uk/tro](http://www.southend.gov.uk/tro) until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made.
3. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any relevant requirements thereof or any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
4. A copy of each of the made Orders and all relevant documents can be inspected on the Ground Floor of the Civic Centre (address below) during normal office hours.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Southend-on-Sea City Council proposes to make the amendments to the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.
2. The general effect of the Orders will be:

**PTO1039-5097 – Hampton Gardens (Bend)**

- **To introduce** No Waiting at Any Times restrictions (double yellow lines) on the South side of the road, on bend of Hampton Gardens; from the common boundary No.80 & No.82 to the common boundary of No.94 & No.96.
- **To extend** the existing No Waiting at Any Time restrictions (double yellow lines) on the North side of the road, on the bend of Hampton Gardens, in the northern direction, to opposite the common boundary of No.94 & No.96.

**PTO1041-5099 – Kathleen Drive (Bend)**

- **To introduce** No Waiting at Any Times restrictions (double yellow lines) on the South side of the road, on bend of Kathleen Drive, from the existing restrictions at the junction to opposite the common boundary of No.5 & No.7.


1. This Order shall come into operation on and may be cited as “The Southend-on-Sea City Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No.2) Order 2023 (PTO1039-5097 – Hampton Gardens - Bend).
2. “The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2021 (PTO1005)” (the 2021 Order) is amended as follows.

**Amendments**

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to the liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the 2021 Order and shall have effect:-
  - a) the items represented on the plans in Schedule 1 to this Order shall replace those plans as listed in the appropriate Schedule to the 2021 Order.

### **The purpose of the proposals is to:-**

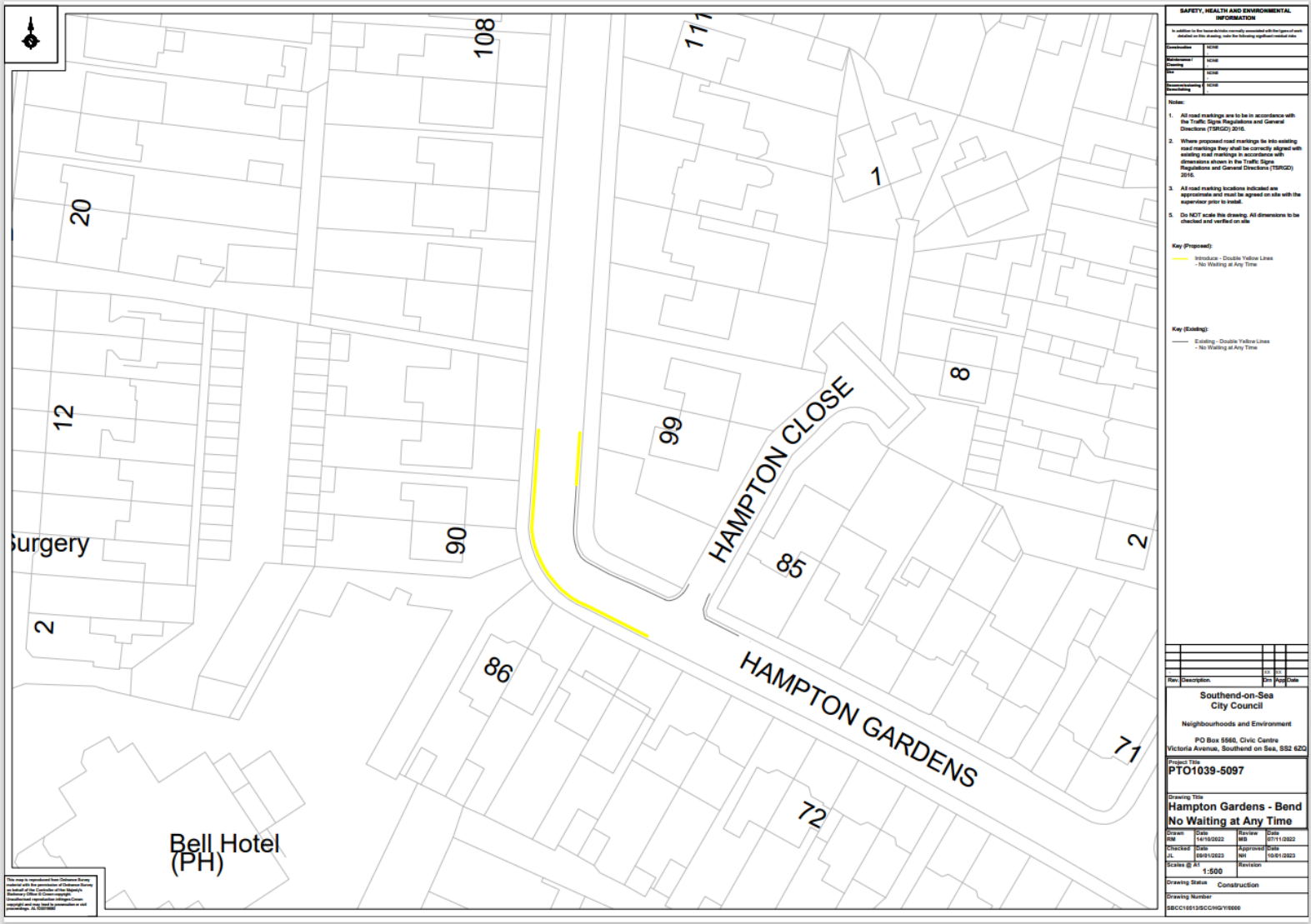
- a) To introduce No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow line) restrictions on the south side of the bend of Hampton Gardens.
- b) To extend the No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow line) restrictions on the north side of the bend of Hampton Gardens.

## **Statement of Reasons for**

### **Proposals: To introduce No Waiting at Any Time restrictions and to amend the No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on the bend of Hampton Gardens.**

No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow line) restrictions are proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, and for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic including pedestrians being seen and wishing to cross the road on a bend. This is essential for the safety of pedestrians and visibility for all.

- All road marking locations indicated are approximate and must be agreed on site with the supervisor prior to install.
- Do NOT scale the drawing. All dimensions to be checked and verified on site.
