

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN ACCESS) (TTO 2335) ORDER 2025  
(CHALKWELL STATION EAST FOOTBRIDGE, THE RIDGEWAY)**

Notice is given that the Southend-on-Sea City Council under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has proposed to make the above Order. The effect of the Order will be as follows:

**Southend-on-Sea City Council will be closing Chalkwell Station East Footbridge, which connects Chalkwell Station to Chalkwell Beach, due to public safety concerns.**

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a temporary prohibition pedestrian access on Chalkwell Station East Footbridge on The Ridgeway.

Diversion route will be as follows: The Ridgeway – Chalkwell Avenue – Chalkwell Esplanade.

**The Order and prohibitions will come into effect on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025** this Order will continue in force for 6 months.
