

SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING
AND UNLOADING ORDER 2025
HAMPTON GARDENS, BRYNE DRIVE, OAKENGRANGE DRIVE, MANNERS CORNER,
ALTON GARDENS, MANNERS WAY SERVICE ROAD (WEST) & MANNERS WAY.

Notice is hereby given that Southend-on-Sea City Council intends, no less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

These works will be undertaken in phases and displayed on site with dates

The Effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from; -

1. Entering and exiting Hampton Gardens at its junction with Manners Way
2. Entering and exiting Bryne Drive at its junction with Manners Way
3. Entering and exiting Oakengrange Drive at its junction with Manners Way
4. Entering and exiting Hampton Gardens at its junction with Manners Way
5. Entering and exiting Manners Corner at its junction with Manners Way
6. Entering and exiting Alton Gardens at its junction with Manners Way
7. Entering and exiting Manners Way Service Road (west) from Manners Way to outside Nayland House
8. Parking, stopping, waiting, loading or unloading on Manners Way from Cuckoo Corner Roundabout to Harp House Roundabout. (This will be in phases)
9. Parking, stopping, waiting, loading or unloading on Manners Way Service Road (west) from Manners Way to outside Nayland House

The closure & suspensions are scheduled to commence from 09:30 on the 26th May 2025 until 15:30 on 30th of July 2025 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The alternative routes for local traffic will be displayed on site.

The Order will come into effect on 26th May 2025 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst Gas Main replacement works takes place.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
