TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND SUSPENSION OF LIMITED WAITING
BAYS ORDER 2025
HAMLET COURT ROAD IN HARMONY FESTIVAL 2025

Notice is hereby given that to enable the Harmony in Hamlet Court Road Festival 2025 to take place in Hamlet Court Road the Council of Southend-on-Sea City intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be, to introduce the temporary prohibitions listed, at the locations listed in Table 1.

The Order would come into force on 18th May 2025 and will continue in operation until the conclusion of the event, however, the Order will continue for a maximum duration of 3 days.

The prohibitions would only have the effect at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of appropriate traffic signs and they would not apply to any vehicle or person connected with the event.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for emergency vehicles, official event vehicles and pedestrians. Any vehicle in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) and may be removed or relocated by a lifting vehicle.

Hamlet Court Road	From the junction with Canewdon Road to the junction with St Helens Road (road closure)	Traffic and parking
Ditton Court Road	At the junction of Hamlet Court Road (road closure)	Traffic and parking
Hamlet Court Road	On the western side of the road from the junction with Canewdon Road to outside No.117 And on the eastern side of the road from the junction with Canewdon Road to outside No.126	Suspension of Limited Waiting bays.
