SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND PARKING) (TTN25-26-09) NOTICE 2025 (QUEENSWAY UNDERPASS, SOUTHEND-ON-SEA)

Notice is given that the Southend-on-Sea City Council under Section 14(2)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, have imposed an emergency temporary prohibition of traffic (including stopping, waiting, loading and unloading) and parking. The effect of this Notice will be as follows:

- 1. Marlborough Highways Ltd will be carrying out emergency work to facilitate the repair of gullies. Whilst this Notice is in operation vehicles will be prohibited from traffic (including stopping, waiting, loading and unloading) and parking on Queensway Underpass.
- 2. These prohibitions to facilitate the work will come into effect on 13th June 2025, work is expected to be complete on 13th June 2025, however, this Notice will remain in force for a maximum of 21 days to allow for unexpected events/delays and possible remedial works. The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.
- 3. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a penalty charge notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004. This Notice will not apply to:
 - a) Anything done at the direction of a police officer in uniform, or a police community support officer (PCSO);
 - b) Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - c) Any official vehicle or person in connection with the works.
