## THE SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (MOVING TRAFFIC AND SPEED LIMIT) AMENDMENT NO.1 ORDER 2025 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Southend-on-Sea City Council has made the above named Order under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 19, 65, 122 and 124 (and parts I, II and IV of Schedule 9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended and of all other enabling powers, and having regard to Section 122 of the Act after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act.

The effect of this Order coming into effect on 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 2025 is as follows:

- To introduce a Bus Gate for use by Buses, Licensed Taxis, Pedal Cycles and Private Hire Vehicles in Queensway, connecting Queensway to Queensway Service Road Victoria Station.
- The definitions for the following will be included in Order:
   Bus Gate, Bus Only Street, Bus Lane and Private Hire Vehicle.

A copy of the Signed Order, the statement of reasons for making the Order and plans showing the affected streets can be inspected during normal office hours, inclusive for a period of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made:

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Orders apply to the High Court for this purpose.
