

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING, LOADING
AND UNLOADING (TTO25-26-23) ORDER 2025
PRIORY CRESCENT, OLIVE AVENUE, WOODGRANGE DRIVE, RAYLEIGH ROAD**

Notice is hereby given that Southend-on-Sea City Council has proposed to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from traffic, stopping, waiting, loading, unloading and parking at the locations stated in Table 1 of this Notice.

The prohibitions and closures are to commence from 08 September 2025 until 01 May 2026 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The alternative routes for Priory Crescent will be via:

- a) East Street, Sutton Road, Eastern Avenue, Priory Crescent and vice versa.
- b) Victoria Avenue to Priory Crescent

The Order will come into effect on 08 September 2025 until 01 May 2026, however this Order may continue in force for a maximum of 18 months to allow for remedial work and delays.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst work is carried out for the resurfacing of the footway.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004.

Priory Crescent	Traffic, parking, stopping, waiting loading and unloading	All junctions from Victoria Avenue to Eastern Avenue	08 Sep 2025 – 14 Nov 2025
Olive Avenue	Parking, stopping, waiting loading and unloading	From its junction with Stirling Avenue to Castlepoint boundary	17 Nov 2025 – 23 Jan 2026
Woodgrange Drive	Parking, stopping, waiting loading and unloading	From its junction with Kensington Avenue to its junction with Chelsworth Crescent West.	26 Jan 2026 – 01 May 2026
Rayleigh Road	Parking, stopping, waiting loading and unloading	From Bosworth Road to its junction with Bellhouse Road.	30 Sep 2025 - 19 Dec 2025
