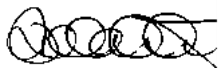
THE SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL (WAITING, LOADING, STOPPING AND PARKING PLACES) (MAP BASED) (BRENDON WAY / SNAKES LANE JUNCTION) AMENDMENT NO.13 ORDER 2025

Southend-on-Sea City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 122 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the 1984 Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to the liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Consolidation) Order 2021 (as amended) (To be known as 'The 2021 Order') shall have effect as though:
 - (i) The items represented on the plans in Schedule 1 to this Order shall replace those corresponding plans as listed in the appropriate Schedule to the 2021 Order (as amended).
2. The effect of this Order proposes to extend the current No Waiting at Any Time restrictions (double yellow lines) on the south side of Snakes Lane, extending from the existing restrictions at the junction of Brendon Way to the mini roundabout, approximately 33 metres.
3. The remainder of The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Consolidation) Order 2021 (as amended) shall remain in full force and effect.
4. This Order shall come into effect on the 21st October 2025 and may be cited as "The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Consolidation) Order 2021. The Southend-On-Sea City Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Brendon Way / Snakes Lane Junction) Amendment No.13 Order 2025".
