

**THE SOUTHEND BOROUGH COUNCIL (WAITING, LOADING, STOPPING AND PARKING PLACES) (MAP BASED) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2021**

**THE SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL (WAITING, LOADING, STOPPING AND PARKING PLACES) (MAP BASED) (PROGRESS ROAD) AMENDMENT NO.18 ORDER 2025**

Notice is hereby given that Southend-on-Sea City Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 , and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act has made the following Orders:

The effect of the Traffic Regulation Orders (TROs) would be as follows:

**PTO1297 – Progress Road**

- The 10 metre (m) taxi rank outside No.60 Progress Road is proposed to be revoked and replace with 10m of No Waiting at Any Time (double yellow lines).
- The 12m taxi rank outside No.60 Progress Road is proposed to be revoked and replace with 12m of No Waiting at Any Time.
- To introduce 6m of No Waiting at Any Time outside No.60 Progress Road.
- The proposal is to revoke 10m of No Waiting at Any Time adjacent to No.1 Brunel Road, replacing this with an 10m taxi rank.
- The proposal is to revoke 12m of No Waiting at Any Time opposite No.55 Progress Road, replacing this with an 12m taxi rank.

The amendments shall come into operation on 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2025 and may be cited as ‘The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map-Based) (Consolidation) Order 2021’:

- ‘The Southend-on-Sea City Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map-Based) (Fairfield Road) Amendment No.18 Order 2025’.

The changes for On-street parking will amend the following Order; ‘The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Consolidation) Order 2021’. Copies of the Order, which will come into operation on 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2025, the statement of reasons for making the Order and plans showing the affected streets can be inspected during normal office hours, inclusive for a period of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made at the Civic Centre, Victoria Avenue, Southend-on-Sea, SS2 6ER and at <https://www.southend.gov.uk/tro>.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
