

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING,
LOADING AND UNLOADING (TTO26-27-03) ORDER 2026
(CAULFIELD ROAD).**

Notice is hereby given that Southend-on-Sea City Council has proposed to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping, waiting, loading, unloading and parking at Caulfield Road from the junction of Ness Road roundabout to the junction of Richmond Avenue.

The closure is scheduled to commence between 8am until 5pm on 30 January 2026 until 2 February 2026 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The alternative routes will be via Ness Road roundabout, Delaware Road, Maplin Way and vice versa.

The Order will come into effect on 30 January 2026 until 2 February 2026; however, this Order may continue in force for a maximum of 18 months to allow for remedial work or delays.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce to facilitate planned roadworks maintenance.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
