

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING,
LOADING AND UNLOADING (TTO26-27-11) ORDER 2026
(BRIGHTEN ROAD)**

Notice is hereby given that Southend-on-Sea City Council intends, no less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from Traffic, stopping, waiting, loading, unloading and parking in the entirety of Brighten Road.

The closures are scheduled to commence in Brighten Road or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The alternative route will be via North Road and to turn left onto London Road.

The Order will come into effect on 18 February 2026 until on 3 March 2026 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst reconstruction of an existing vehicle crossing takes place with activity between the hours of 8am and 5pm

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
