Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Southend-on-Sea City Council has made the above named Orders under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 33, 35, 45, 46 and 124 (and part IV of Schedule 9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended and of all other enabling powers, and having regard to Section 122 of the Act after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act.

The effect of these Orders coming into effect on 1st April 2026 is as follows:

On street:

Southend-on-Sea City Council have made the following amendments to on street provisions:

- Update the provisions of Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Places to prevent non-electric vehicles and electric vehicles which are not connected to and actively charging from the charging point from parking in those existing parking places.
- Amend the terms and conditions of all Permits to remove eligibility for refunds.
- Re-designation of payment parking tariff zones, and associated charges where applicable.
- Updates to the terms and conditions to ensure current tariffs align with operational hours and zones for shared use payment parking places in permit parking zones where applicable.
- Removal of the existing Resident Permit – Electric Vehicle.
- Amend the Resident Concessionary Permit by removing the single permit option and splitting into 4 different zones aligned to the relevant tariff zones and implementing a new charging structure.
- Amend the terms and conditions of the Hotels and guesthouses discount rate to apply in Zones 1 and 2 only.
- Change the name of the Educational Permit to Educational and Employment Permit, all other provisions remain unaffected.
- Introduction of Visitor Vouchers (Virtual/Electronic Book of 20) with a 4 hour maximum stay.
- Update the charge for amendments to Permits from £10 per change to no charge for 1st change and £10 for subsequent changes (per change) which resets each time the Permit is renewed.

Off street:

Southend-on-Sea City Council have made the following amendments to off street provisions:

- Update the provisions of Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Places to prevent non-electric vehicles and electric vehicles which are not connected to and actively charging from the charging point from parking in those parking places.
- Amend the terms and conditions of Seafront Permits, Season Tickets and Southend Passes to remove eligibility for refunds.
- Re-designation of parking zones for Season Tickets and Seafront Permits, and associated charges.
- Amend the terms and conditions of Coach Parking to include VAT where applicable.

- Amend the Resident Concessionary Permit by removing the single permit option and splitting into 4 different zones aligned to the relevant tariff zones and implementing a new charging structure.
- Amend the terms and conditions of the Hotels and guesthouses discount rate to apply in Zones 1 and 2 only.
- Change the name of the Educational Permit to Educational and Employment Permit, all other provisions remain unaffected.
- Update the charge for amendments to Permits and Season Tickets from £10 per change to no charge for 1st change and £10 for subsequent changes (per change) which resets each time the Permit is renewed.
- Update the terms and conditions of free festive parking to only apply in selected Council car parks on selected Sundays in December.
- Change the location of Small Business Day parking from Zones 2 and 3 car parks to selected Council car parks on the first Saturday in December.
- Introduce payment parking in Civic Underground Car Park on weekends and Public/Bank Holidays with Zone 3a charges.
- Introduce payment parking in Beecroft Lower Car Park on Monday to Sunday between 8am and 6pm with Zone 3b charges.
- Introduce a new permit for Beecroft Lower Car Park.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

Southend-on-Sea City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (“the 1984 Act”) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (“the 2004 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to the liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order The SOUTHEND BOROUGH COUNCIL (WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING AND PARKING PLACES) (MAP BASED) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2021 (To be known as ‘The 2021 Order’) and shall have effect;
 - (i) The removal of permits and charges described in Schedule 1 to this Order from Article 5 of The 2021 Order (as amended).
 - (ii) The insertion of new entries and new charges described in Schedule 2 to this Order into Article 5 of The 2021 Order (as amended).
 - (iii) Replace Article 24(n)(v) of The 2021 Order (as amended) with the following:
24(n)(v) is not an Electric Vehicle and is parked within an Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Place;
 - (iv) Introduce the following Article after Article 24(n)(v) of The 2021 Order (as amended) as follows:
24(n)(vi) is an Electric Vehicle parked within an Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Place and is not connected to and actively charging via the recharging lead attached to the Recharging Post relating to that Parking Place.
 - (v) Replace Article 6(f) of The 2021 Order (as amended) with the following:
6(f) Any applicant for a Permit shall not be entitled to a refund.

2. The effect of this Order is (this article is an explanatory note this is not part of the Order):
 - (i) Update the provisions of Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Places to prevent non-electric vehicles and electric vehicles which are not connected to and actively charging from the charging point from parking in those existing parking places.

 - (iii) Re-designation of payment parking tariff zones, and associated charges where applicable.
 - (iv) Updates to the terms and conditions to ensure current tariffs align with operational hours and zones for shared use payment parking places in permit parking zones where applicable.
 - (v) Removal of the existing Resident Permit – Electric Vehicle.
 - (vi) Amend the Resident Concessionary Permit by removing the single permit option and splitting into 4 different zones aligned to the relevant tariff zones and implementing a new charging structure.
 - (vii) Amend the terms and conditions of the Hotels and guesthouses discount rate to apply in Zones 1 and 2 only.
 - (viii) Change the name of the Educational Permit to Educational and Employment Permit, all other provisions remain unaffected.

- (ix) Introduction of Visitor Vouchers (Virtual/Electronic Book of 20) with a 4 hour maximum stay.
 - (x) Update the charge for amendments to Permits from £10 per change to no charge for 1st change and £10 for subsequent changes (per change) which resets each time the Permit is renewed.
3. The remainder of THE Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading and Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Consolidation) Order 2021 (as amended) shall remain in full force and effect.

1. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to the liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order THE SOUTHEND BOROUGH COUNCIL TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER THE SOUTHEND (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2022 (as amended) (To be known as ‘The 2022 Order’) and shall have effect;
 - (i) The removal of permits and charges described in Schedule 1 to this Order from Schedule 3 of The 2022 Order (as amended).
 - (ii) The insertion of new entries and new charges described in Schedule 2 to this Order into Schedule 3 of The 2022 Order (as amended).
 - (iii) The removal of charges described in Schedule 3 to this Order from Schedule 2 of The 2022 Order (as amended).
 - (iv) The insertion of new entries and new charges described in Schedule 4 to this Order into Schedule 2 of The 2022 Order (as amended).
 - (v) The table set out in Schedule 5 to this order will replace the items in Schedule 1 of The 2022 Order (as amended).
 - (vi) Replace Article 4(a)(viii) of The 2022 Order (as amended) with the following:

4(a)(viii) is not an Electric Vehicle and is parked within an Electric Vehicle Charging Parking Place;
 - (vii) Introduce the following Article after Article 4(a)(viii) of The 2022 Order (as amended) as follows:

8(f) A Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass is valid only in the car park or Zone applied for (unless otherwise specified in the terms and conditions relating to that Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass), no concessions are made in any other car park.

- Removal of the existing Resident Permit – Electric Vehicle.
- Amend the Resident Concessionary Permit by removing the single permit option and splitting into 4 different zones aligned to the relevant tariff zones and implementing a new charging structure.
- Amend the terms and conditions of the Hotels and guesthouses discount rate to apply in Zones 1 and 2 only.
- Change the name of the Educational Permit to Educational and Employment Permit, all other provisions remain unaffected.
- Introduction of Visitor Vouchers (Virtual/Electronic Book of 20) with a 4 hour maximum stay.
- Update the charge for amendments to Permits from £10 per change to no charge for 1st change and £10 for subsequent changes (per change) which resets each time the Permit is renewed.

Off street:

- Amend the terms and conditions of Seafront Permits, Season Tickets and Southend Passes to remove eligibility for refunds.
- Re-designation of parking zones for Season Tickets and Seafront Permits, and associated charges.
- Amend the terms and conditions of Coach Parking to include VAT where applicable.
- Amend the Resident Concessionary Permit by removing the single permit option and splitting into 4 different zones aligned to the relevant tariff zones and implementing a new charging structure.
- Amend the terms and conditions of the Hotels and guesthouses discount rate to apply in Zones 1 and 2 only.
- Change the name of the Educational Permit to Educational and Employment Permit, all other provisions remain unaffected.
- Update the charge for amendments to Permits and Season Tickets from £10 per change to no charge for 1st change and £10 for subsequent changes (per change) which resets each time the Permit is renewed.
- Update the terms and conditions of free festive parking to only apply in selected Council car parks on selected Sundays in December.

- Change the location of Small Business Day parking from Zones 2 and 3 car parks to selected Council car parks on the first Saturday in December.
- Introduce payment parking in Civic Underground Car Park on weekends and Public/Bank Holidays with Zone 3a charges.
- Introduce payment parking in Beecroft Lower Car Park on Monday to Sunday between 8am and 6pm with Zone 3b charges.
- Introduce a new permit for Beecroft Lower Car Park.

Alongside the proposals listed above, changes will also be made to some on-street and off-street charges. These changes will be introduced by varying the charges currently in place. Full details can be found in the Public Notice included within the deposit document.

Reasons

The Council regularly reviews its parking fees and charges, in conjunction with monitoring transactional and financial income data.

The primary reason for charging for parking is to effectively manage kerb-side space and demand, in both central on-street locations and car parks as well as residential and business areas. Effective parking management will aim to support wider transport policy objectives, ensuring that on and off-street space is used more effectively.

Effective management of parking provision is recognised as making a significant contribution to reducing congestion, whilst supporting access to residents, visitors and businesses.

Parking charges need to be set at a level which facilitates local use and demand and at a level which will ensure the effective management of parking provision by prioritising access to the local community and promoting a sustainable and vibrant local economy. These proposals are expected to further encourage footfall and visitors to the city beyond existing levels, whilst ensuring charges are applied consistently and fairly across Southend, as the proposals may also help customers make more informed decisions about where, when and for how long they park.

These proposals include introducing payment parking in the Civic Underground Car Park and Beecroft Lower Car Park to accommodate parking needs within the City, the redesignation of tariff zones for Season Tickets and Seafront Permits to simplify the charging levels along with other minor changes to the on and off-street orders.

This also includes changes to the provisions of electric vehicle charging places to ensure electric vehicles have maintained access to recharging points, encouraging more sustainable transport options relating to climate change and net zero.

Additional reasons include;

- Supports the council's network management duty under the Traffic Management Act 2004.
- To cover the ongoing expenses incurred in the effective management of parking, including monitoring and enforcement of parking restrictions and the operation and maintenance of associated assets and facilities within the City.
- To ensure that the Council continues to effectively manage the demand for parking within the City to ensure that residents, businesses, and visitors receive the best parking service from the Council.
- Account for inflationary increases.

Any income generated from on-street parking charges will be utilised to effectively manage parking in the first instance. Any surplus generated by the operation of the on-street parking service is used for other improvements in traffic management, highway improvements, environmental improvements, and subsidised and concessionary transport. This is in accordance with the current

legislation and associated regulations.

Legislation

Charges for on-street parking can be varied by Notice under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Section 46a and compliance with Part V, Section 25 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996. Due to additional changes being required for both on and off-street provisions, as set out in the proposal section of this document, an amendment Order for on-street, and separate amendment Order for off-street, will cover all changes proposed, including the increased charges element.

The specific grounds with which the Council are using for the implementation of the proposals are encompassed in Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 44, 45, 46, 46A, and 124(1)(d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

In considering whether to make this Order, Southend-on-Sea City Council has had regard to all relevant matters including its responsibility pursuant to Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), to secure so far as practicable the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians), and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway having regard to the matters specified in Section 122(2).

The Council of Southend Borough, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and of all other enabling powers, and having consulted with the Chief Officer of Police, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation Commencement and Revocation

1. a) This Order may be cited as The Southend Borough Council (Waiting, Loading, Stopping and Parking Places) (Map Based) (Consolidation) Order 2021 (TT1001) (the 2021 Order) and shall come into force on 8th February 2021.
b) All traffic orders relating to waiting, loading, stopping and designated parking places, loading bays and any permit holder bays up to the date of the making of this Order will hereby consolidated within the 2021 Order.

Interpretation

2. (a) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.
(b) In this Order:-
“**the 1984 Act**” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
“**the 1986 Regulations**” means the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986;
“**the 1988 Act**” means the Road Traffic Act 1988;
“**the 1994 Act**” means the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994;
“**the 2000 Regulations**” means the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

“the 2016 Regulations” means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

“the 2004 Act” means the Traffic Management Act 2004;

“the 2007 Regulations” means Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007

“ambulance” has the same meaning as in section 6(2) of the 1994 Act;

“civil enforcement officer” or **“CEO”** has the same meaning as in section 76 of the 2004 Act;

“the Council” means the Southend Borough Council;

“disabled person’s badge” or **“blue badge”** has the same meaning as in Regulation 3 of the 2000 Regulations;

“disabled person’s vehicle” means a vehicle which displays a valid disabled person’s badge in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 4 and 5 of the 2000 Regulations;

“dispensation certificate” means a valid dispensation issued by the Council for the purpose of exempting a vehicle from the parking restrictions set out at the location set out in the dispensation and used in accordance with its terms and conditions;

“displaying” means displaying in the relevant position;

“driver” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the 2016 Regulations;

“electric vehicle” means a vehicle in which the electrical motive power is derived from an electrical battery which is not connected to any source of power when the vehicle is in motion;

“eligible address” means a postal address included in the relevant permit terms and conditions and in Appendix 1 to this Order;

“emergency vehicle” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the 2016 Regulations;

“footway” has the same meaning as in Section 329 of the Highways Act;

“goods” means goods or burden of any kind and includes postal packets of any description; and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods, include checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

“goods vehicle” and **“maximum gross weight”** have the same meanings as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (as amended);

“initial charge” means the payment referred to in article 4;

“motorcycle” has the same meaning as in the Part 1 of Regulation 3 of the 1986 Regulations;

“outstanding” has the same definition as Part 1 Regulation 2 of the 2007 Regulations;

“overall height” and **“overall length”** have the same meaning as in Part 1 of Regulation 3 of the 1986 Regulations;

“owner” in relation to a vehicle, means the person is the keeper and user of that vehicle;

“parking disc” has the same meaning as in Regulation 3 of the 2000 Regulations;

“parking place” means an area of road designated under Article 3 and shall include **“parking space”** being that part of a parking place marked out individually in accordance with the 2016 Regulations and marked with a traffic sign in accordance with Schedule 1 of the 2016 Regulations or Department of Transport approved signs commensurate with the appropriate restriction and use specified in the schedule to this Order ;

“pay and display ticket” means a ticket issued by a pay and display machine;

“pay and display machine” means a parking meter as defined in the 1984 Act;

“penalty charge” and **“reduced penalty charge”** has the same meaning as section 77 and Schedule 9 of the 2004 Act;

“permit” means any valid parking permit or season ticket issued by the Council and used in accordance with its terms and conditions and, unless the contrary intention appears, includes both physical and virtual permits;

“permit holder” refers to each person or organisation to which a relevant permit has been issued by the Council;

“permit parking place” mean a parking place specified in the Schedule to this Order and includes shared use parking places;

“permitted hours” in relation to a parking place, means the period specified in the Schedule relating to that parking place;

“physical”, in relation to a permit, scratch card or dispensation, means intended to be displayed;

“police vehicle” has the same meaning as in the 2016 Regulations;

“plan” means a scaled drawing giving the relative start and end to each restriction and where necessary indicates the type of restriction that applies;

“recharging post” means a device designed for the recharging of electric vehicles;

“restricted street” means any of the sides or length of street specified within the Schedules and extends from the centreline of the carriageway to the street boundary;

“restricted parking zone” has the same meaning as in the 2016 Regulations with the extent and eligibility as outlined in Appendix 1 to this Order;

“relevant position” in respect of:-

- (i) a disabled person’s badge or a parking disc has the same meaning as section 4 of the 2000 regulations;
- (ii) a physical permit, physical dispensation, physical scratch card or pay and display ticket means it is exhibited on the nearside of the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the permit, dispensation, scratch card or ticket is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;

“road” has the same meaning as in section 142 of the 1984 Act;

“scratch card” means a prepaid permit that requires validation at the time and date of use;

“shared use” in relation to parking places means a parking place in which parking is allowed:

- by ticketless payment, or
- by purchasing a pay and display ticket, or
- through use of a permit of the type specified on the associated traffic sign;

“street” have the same meaning as in section 6(6) of the 1984 Act, the boundary to which means the building line, boundary wall, boundary hedge or fence separating land over which the public do and do not have access;

“Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order and will comprise plans showing the extent and type of restriction as required by this Order and these restriction types will be identified within an appropriate plan using an appropriate key or label;

“school entrance marking” means an area of carriageway identified in the schedule to this Order and identified using the signs and road markings as prescribed in the 2016 Regulations;

“solo motorcycle” has the same meaning as in the 2016 Regulations;

“taxi” and **“taxi rank”** has the same meaning as in the 2016 Regulations;

“teacher” has the same meaning as in the Education Act 2002;

“ticketless payment” means to make a payment for an act of parking within a pay-by-phone parking place having first registered an account with the appropriate service provider;

“**unladen weight**” has the same meaning as in the 1986 Regulations;

“**vehicle**” has the same meaning as motor vehicle in the 1988 Act and includes any part of a vehicle.

“**virtual**”, in relation to a permit, scratch card or dispensation, means not physical.

Designation of Parking Places

- 3. Each area of road comprising the lengths of carriageway, street and footway specified in the Schedules and indicated by a traffic sign on the carriageway that is compliant with the 2016 Regulations is designated as a parking place in accordance with the Act of 1984.

Charges for Parking Places and Permits

- 4. (a) The rates payable are outlined in the article 5(this needs to be clarified by SEBC as to where they want to have the fees and charges) to this Order and indicated where appropriate on the relevant pay and display machine to that bay. If payment is made using ticketless payment options (mobile phone payment) the hourly rates are confirmed through the appropriate ticketless payment method
 - (b) Incremental payments for parts of an hour may be made to the maximum stay applicable to that parking place with the maximum permitted length of stay being indicated within each parking place.
 - (c) The charge for parking in contravention to the restrictions described within this Order pursuant to the 2004 Act and Regulation 24 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007.

General Conditions for Permits

6. (a) The Council may at any time require an applicant for a permit to produce to an officer of the Council such evidence in respect of an application for a permit.
- (b) Upon receipt of a successful application and upon receipt of the specified charge in Article 4 to this Order, the Council shall issue to the applicant one permit or register the applicant with a virtual permit.
- (c) Eligibility to permits will be reduced commensurate to the availability of parking within the curtilage of the applicant's address.
- (d) A permit holder shall surrender a permit to the Council at any time upon request if one of the following circumstances prevails.
 - (i) The permit holder ceases to be a resident, business or other permit holder as listed in this Order.
 - (ii) The permit holder ceases to be the owner or keeper of the relevant vehicle.
 - (iii) The Council have withdrawn the permit.
 - (iv) The vehicle has been adapted so as not to comply with the conditions on application.
 - (v) The permit has been faded, mutilated or defaced to leave it invalid.
 - (vi) A duplicate permit has been issued by the Council.
- (e) The Council may by notice in writing withdraw a permit and cause it to be invalid, if it appears to the Council that any of the issues listed in item (c) to this Article has occurred.
- (f) Any applicant for a permit returned to the Council before the valid from date will be entitled to a full refund.
- (g) Any permit holder who surrenders a valid permit to the Council after the permit has become active shall be entitled to a refund to the value of one twelfth of the value in relation to each remaining complete month left on the appropriate permit.
- (h) Any holder of residents' visitors permits who surrenders them to the Council shall be entitled to a refund to the value of those residents' visitor permits that have not been activated in any way.
- (i) The Council on receipt of a mutilated, defaced or faded permit will issue a duplicate permit for the appropriate fee in Article 4.
- (j) The Council will issue a duplicate permit to any permit holder if the permit has been lost, destroyed or stolen and for the appropriate fee in Article 4.

Application for and issue of resident or business user permit

7. Any resident or business being the owner of a vehicle of the class specified in Article 26(h) to this Order and occupiers of an eligible address may apply to the Council for a permit in respect to that vehicle under the conditions in Article 6 to this Order and at a cost as specified in Article 5 to this Order.

Application for and use of essential service permits

8. (a) Details of the qualifying criteria to apply for an essential service permit can be obtained from the Council's Parking Service and applications may be made for 'essential service permits' or 'short stay essential service permits' under the conditions in Article 6 to this Order and at a cost as specified in Article 5 to this Order.
(b) Essential service permits will allow parking within all controlled parking places within the borough.
(c) Short stay essential service permits will also be able to park within permit parking places within all controlled parking but will be limited to a maximum stay of 3 hours per day.
9. Any organisation being the owner of a vehicle of a class specified in Article 23(h) may apply for an essential service.
10. Applicants will be limited to one essential service permit at the discretion of the appropriate delegated authority.

Application for and use of resident's visitor vouchers

11. Any resident over the age of 18 may apply to the Council for a residents' visitors permit in respect to a vehicle of the class specified in Article 23(h) under the conditions in Article 6 to this Order and at a cost as specified in Article 5 to this Order.

The Council reserve the right to limit the number of residents' visitors permits issued at one time

12. A resident's visitors permit shall cease to be valid after a period of 3 years from the date of issue.
13. Residents' visitor permits are only valid in the parking zone to which they apply.

Application for and use of special parking permits

14. (a) Any resident or person acting on their behalf may apply to the Council for a special parking permit in respect to a vehicle of the class specified in Article 23(h) under the conditions in Article 6 to this Order and at a cost as specified in Article 5 to this Order.
(b) The decision to issue a special parking permit is at the discretion of the appropriate delegated authority of the Council with the following issues to be considered:
 - (i) The applicant's exceptional medical needs.
 - (ii) The applicant's exceptional social needs.

- (iii) The exceptional difficulty experienced by an applicant who is carer for any other person or persons.

Application for and use of car club permits

- 15. Any car club organisation registered with the Council may apply to the Council for a car club permit in respect to a vehicle of the class specified in Article 23(h) under the conditions in Article 6 to this Order and at a cost as specified in Article 5 to this Order.

Application for and use of Tradesman's Permits

- 16. Traders permits available to trades people carrying out work in properties in the borough and will be issued to the specific roads where the work is being undertaken.
- 17. Those permits are not refundable.

Application for and use of Temporary Permits

- 18. Residents who do not have the required documentation for a yearly permit can apply for a temporary permit.

Application for and use of Southend Pass

- 19. Residents may apply for a Southend Pass for use within any of the 4 zones. Southend Pass can be used in any zone for up to 3 hours in each zone.

Application for and use of Yellow Line Dispensation

- 20. Any person may apply for a dispensation for parking on yellow lines if no suitable alternative parking is available and the vehicle is required to be very close to the premises. This dispensation only applies to single yellow lines.

General Prohibitions Applying to Waiting, Loading, Stopping

NO WAITING

- 21. Save as provided in Articles 26 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the roads subject to restrictions identified as No Waiting during a specified time limit, for the periods identified on the plans attached in Schedule 1 to this Order.

NO LOADING

- 22. Save as provided in Articles 26 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload on the roads or sides of the roads subject to restrictions identified as No loading during a specified time limit, for the periods identified on the plans attached in Schedule 1 to this Order.

NO STOPPING

- 23. Save as provided in Articles 25 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in

uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to stop on the roads or sides of the roads subject to restrictions identified as No Stopping during a specified time limit, for the periods identified on the plans attached in Schedule 1 to this Order.

General prohibitions applying to parking and loading bays

24. Save as provided in Article 27 of this Order no person shall cause a vehicle to stop or remain in a parking place during permitted hours: -

- (a) for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting in relation to that parking place and indicated by traffic signs adjacent to the parking place.
- (b) before the expiration of the time shown on the traffic sign adjacent to the parking when a vehicle is permitted to return to the same parking place.
- (c) if the vehicle is not parked wholly within a parking place.
- (d) if the vehicle is parked in a disabled person's bay and is not displaying a disabled person's badge and a parking disc.
- (e) If the vehicle is waiting in a loading parking place and continuous loading is not taking place.
- (f) if the vehicle is not a goods vehicle and is waiting in a loading parking place designated for goods vehicles only.
- (g) if the vehicle is using a parking place and goods are being sold or offered for sale from a vehicle without an appropriate licence for that parking space from the Council.
- (h) if the vehicle; -
 - (i) has an unladen weight exceeding 3500kg.
 - (ii) exceeds 2.3m in overall height.
 - (iii) exceeds 5.25m in overall length.
- (i) in relation to a permit parking place, if the vehicle parked has not been registered with a virtual permit or is not displaying a valid physical permit that relates to and is valid within that parking place.
- (j) if the parking place is suspended.
- (k) if the vehicle is a motorcycle parked in any bay not being a motorcycle parking place.
- (l) if the vehicle has three or more outstanding PCNs from the Council.
- (m) if a permit or badge or ticket displayed in the relevant position is used or have been obtained by fraud.
- (n) To wait or remain during permitted hours in a parking place if the vehicle parked: -
 - (i) is not displaying in the relevant position a valid pay and display ticket applicable for the time and parking place or space.

- (ii) has not used and confirmed the alternative ticketless payment options provided by the Council and indicated on signs adjacent to the parking place.
- (iii) is displaying a pay and display ticket transferred from another vehicle.
- (iv) in relation to shared use parking place if both paragraphs (i) and (j) apply.
- (v) is an electric vehicle parked within an electric vehicle charging parking place as indicated in the Schedule to this Order shall cause that vehicle to be connected and be actively recharging via the recharging lead attached to the recharging post relating to that parking place.

Exemptions to the General Prohibitions

25. Nothing in this Order shall apply to the following: -

- (a) a vehicle where the person in control of the vehicle is.
 - (i) required by law to stop; or
 - (ii) obliged to stop to prevent an accident; or
 - (iii) prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside their control; or
 - (iv) caused or permitted to stop or wait upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform.
- (b) a vehicle in the service of the Council being necessarily used in connection with highway maintenance, parking enforcement, waste collection or street cleansing activities in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
- (c) a vehicle: -
 - (i) being used by the fire brigade, ambulance service or police for emergency purposes; or
 - (ii) attending an emergency and being used by a doctor, district nurse or midwife where evidence is provided to show a genuine emergency; or
 - (iii) being used by naval, military or air force visiting forces if at any time they are being used or appropriated by such forces.
- (a) a vehicle validly displaying a dispensation in accordance with the Council's terms and conditions of use.
- (b) a vehicle in the service of a universal service provider as defined in section 4 of the Postal Services Act 2000 being used for delivering or collecting postal packets from an adjacent property.

26. Nothing in Article 5, 6 and 7 in this Order shall apply to the following: -

- (a) a vehicle taking in fuel, oil or water at the kerbside if such action cannot be achieved unless the vehicle waits in the parking place where it is waiting.

- (b) a vehicle that is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable a person and their personal luggage to actively board or alight from that vehicle.

27. Nothing in Article 24 in this Order shall apply to the following: -

- (a) a vehicle that is waiting other than in an electric vehicle charging parking place, only for so long as to enable goods to be actively loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle.
- (b) a vehicle which is waiting in any charged for parking place which is not suspended with blue badge holder availability and the vehicle is displaying a valid blue badge and where required a parking disc.
- (c) an electric vehicle left in a charged for parking place and that the use of that pay and display parking place in which the vehicle is left has not been suspended
- (d) a motorcycle without a sidecar that is parked perpendicular and with the rear wheel nearest the kerb in any parking place where residents or business permit holders can park.
- (e) if goods are being sold or offered or exposed for sale from the vehicle by a person who is licensed by the Council to sell goods from a stationery vehicle on a pitch situated in the parking place.
- (f) a vehicle being loaded or unloaded so long as the parking place has not been suspended as per Article 28, or that the period of loading does not exceed 20 minutes.
- (g) a police vehicle waiting in a police vehicle parking place.
- (h) a Hackney carriage waiting in a parking place for taxis only.
- (i) an ambulance waiting in an ambulance parking place.

Suspension of Parking Places and Removal of Vehicles

- 28.(a) Any person duly authorised by the Council, may suspend the use of a parking place whenever they consider such a suspension is reasonably necessary for: -
- (i) the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
 - (ii) the purpose of any works adjacent to the parking place.
 - (iii) the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place.
 - (iv) any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed.
 - (v) the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of wedding or funeral or on other special occasions.
 - (vi) the occasion that film crews require the place under the 2008 Act or otherwise.
- (b) A police officer in uniform may direct the suspension of the use of a parking place or any part of the parking place for a period not greater than 7 days to prevent or mitigate congestion or obstruction of traffic, or danger to or from traffic in consequence of extraordinary circumstances
- (c) Any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (a) or (b) of this Article shall place or cause to be placed sign(s) indicating that the use of all or part of the parking place is suspended and that stopping or waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
- (d) No person shall cause a vehicle to stop or wait in any part of a parking place which has been suspended except if the vehicle is being used in an emergency by the fire brigade, ambulance service or police or a vehicle in the service of the Council undertaking statutory works to the street or if it displays a dispensation allowing the vehicle to park in that place.

Removal or the alteration of the position of vehicles in a parking place.

29. A police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer in the case of an emergency or if they reasonably believe a vehicle ed in the parking place may: -
- (a) move or cause to be moved any such vehicle to any place they see fit; or
 - (b) remove or cause to be removed any such vehicle to a place of safe custody.

Coming into force: 1 April 2022

The Council of the City of Southend-on-Sea, after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police for Essex, in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on 1 April 2022 and may be cited as the Southend-On-Sea City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2022 (PTO1023).

2. Interpretation

- a) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them except where the context requires otherwise: -

"the 1984 Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"the 1986 Regulations" means the Road Vehicle (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986;

"the 1988 Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1988;

"the 2000 Regulations" means the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"the 2004 Act" means the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"authorised officer" means a person authorised (by name or designation or both) in writing by the Chief Executive or any Chief Officer of the Council;

"the Council" means the Council of the City of Southend-On-Sea;

"civil enforcement officer" or **"CEO"** has the same meaning as in section 76 of the 2004 Act;

"designated vehicle" means a vehicle authorised by the Council to use specifically reserved parking bays or parking places;

"Disabled Person's Badge", "Disabled Person's Vehicle", "Disabled Person's Parking Disc" and **"relevant position"** have the same meaning as in the 2000 Regulations ;

"driver" in relation to a vehicle in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

“electric vehicle” means a vehicle in which the electrical motive power is derived from an electrical battery which is not connected to any source of power when the vehicle is in motion;

“initial charge” means a charge payable under Article 6;

“initial period” means the period for which it is permissible under the provisions of this Order to leave a vehicle in a parking place on payment of an initial charge;

“location identification number” means the unique number assigned to each type of parking place where the ticketless payment parking system is operational;

“motor car” has the same meaning as in the 1984 Act;

“owner” has the same meaning as in the 2004 Act;

“parking space” means an area of a parking place designated in Schedule 1 to this Order and marked to indicate the limits within which a vehicle may park;

“parking place” means any part of any land or building specified by name in column 2 of Schedule 1;

“pay and display ticket” means a ticket issued by a pay and display machine;

“pay and display machine” means a parking meter as defined in the 1984 Act;

“permitted hours” in relation to a parking place, means the period specified in the Schedule relating to that parking place;

“penalty charge” and **“reduced penalty charge”** has the same meaning as in section 77 and Schedule 9 of the 2004 Act;

“penalty charge notice” means a notice issued or served by a civil enforcement officer pursuant to the provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007;

“permitted vehicle” means a private vehicle or motorcycle (with or without sidecar attached) not exceeding 1.98 metres (6 feet 6 inches) in height, 4.9 metres (16 feet) in length and with a maximum weight of 2.54 tonnes (2.46 tons);

“recharging post” means a device designed for the recharging of electric vehicles;

“seafront permit” means any valid virtual electronic or paper Seafront Permit issued under Article 8 and used in accordance with its terms and conditions;

seafront permit holder refers to each person or organisation to which a relevant seafront permit has been issued by the Council;

“season ticket” and includes **“resident concessionary season ticket”** means any valid (virtual) electronic or paper season ticket issued under Article 8 and used in accordance with its terms and conditions;

season ticket holder refers to each person or organisation to which a relevant season ticket has been issued by the Council;

“service charge” means any charge payable to the service provider (in addition to the ticketless payment in accordance with the provision of Article 7 of this Order and of any relevant amending Orders) for vehicles using the telephone payment parking system;

“solo motorcycle” has the same meaning as in the 2016 Regulations;

“Southend Pass” is a discretionary pass available to residents and visitors and that permits holders to park for a limited period of time in line with its terms and conditions;

“ticketless payment” means to make a payment for an act of parking within a cashless payment parking place having first registered an account with the appropriate service provider;

“vehicle” and **“trailer”** have the same meaning as in the 1984 Act;

- b) Except where the context otherwise requires references in this Order to Articles and to Schedules are references to Articles of and Schedules to this Order.
- c) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order.
- d) Each of the parking places specified in this Order may be used during the permitted hours by vehicles specified in column 2 to Schedule 1 to this Order.

3. Designation and use of parking places

- a) The car parks specified by name in Schedule 1 to this Order are designated as a parking place in accordance with the 1984 Act and may be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order. and the driver.
- a) When a vehicle is left in one of the parking places specified in Schedule 1 to this Order during the charging hours the driver shall ensure that vehicles will only be parked entirely within a marked parking space and shall make the appropriate payment of a charge in accordance with Schedules 2 and 3 to this Order.
- b) The Council may designate parking bays within parking places for specific vehicles which shall be marked in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

4. General prohibitions applying to parking places/spaces

- a) If any vehicle is left in a parking space referred to in this Order and:-
 - (i) the vehicle parked has not been registered with a valid virtual Seafront permit, Season Ticket or Southend Pass or is not displaying a valid physical Seafront permit, Season Ticket or Southend Pass that relates to that parking place;
 - (ii) is not displaying in the relevant position a valid pay and display ticket applicable for the time and parking place or space;
 - (iii) has not used and confirmed the alternative ticketless payment options provided by the Council and indicated on signs adjacent to the parking place;
 - (iv) is displaying a pay and display ticket transferred from another vehicle;
 - (v) does not display a disabled persons parking badge and clock;
 - (vi) the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to remain in a parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in column 4 of Schedule 1 in relation to that parking place;
 - (vii) the vehicle is not entirely parked within a marked parking space;
 - (viii) is an electric vehicle parked within an electric vehicle charging parking place as indicated in this Order and that vehicle is not connected to and actively recharging via the recharging lead attached to the recharging post relating to that parking place.

a civil enforcement officer may attach to that vehicle a penalty charge notice.

- b) Nothing in this Order shall authorise the use of any part of a parking place to be a nuisance or so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the parking place.

5. Exemptions

- a) Nothing in this Order shall prohibit the use of the parking place by vehicles for the purpose of obtaining access to premises under the provisions of Section 34 of the Act of 1984;

- b) Nothing in this Order shall make it unlawful to park a vehicle of any of the following descriptions that is to say:-

- (i) vehicles used for Fire Brigade purposes;
- (ii) vehicles used for police purposes;
- (iii) vehicles used for ambulance purposes;
- (iv) street cleansing vehicles;
- (v) vehicles used for the collection of refuse;
- (vi) vehicles used for the purpose of gritting or salting or the clearance of snow;
- (vii) vehicles used for the purpose of cleansing repairing or maintaining lighting apparatus;
- (viii) vehicles used in connection with the reconstruction alteration or maintenance of or the provision of services to, or supervision of the parking places.

6. Maximum period for which a vehicle may be left in a parking space.

- a) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to remain in a parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in column 4 of Schedule 1 in relation to that parking place.

7. Charges

- a) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall pay an initial charge in accordance with the tariff set out in Schedule 2 to this order which is specified in relation to that parking place in column 5 of Schedule 1.
- b) Off street pay and display bays charges are applicable for each session in addition to the charges incurred from the use of a electric charging bay
- c) The owner of a vehicle may apply for a Southend Pass or Season Ticket in accordance with the tariff set out in Schedule 3 to this Order.

8. General Conditions for, Seafront Permits, Season Tickets and Southend Pass

- a) The Council may at their discretion issue virtual or paper Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass available for issue at one or more named parking place as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

- b) For the purpose of this Order a quarter shall end on 31st March, 30th June, 30th September or 31st December in any year as the case may be.
- c) In relation to Baxter Avenue Car Park, a season ticket may be used only by the person to whom it is issued (or in the case of a ticket issued to a company or firm by an employee of that company or firm in the course of his employment) or by the driver of the vehicle in respect of which it is issued and only for parking in the parking place or places in respect of which it is issued.
- d) In relation to Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass issued for any other car park these will have to be displayed within, or if virtual registered to the specific vehicle at the time of parking.
- e) No person shall use a permit, Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass otherwise than in accordance with the Councils conditions of use.
- f) A Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass is valid only in the car park applied for (unless otherwise specified in the terms and conditions relating to that , Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass), no concessions are made in any other car park
- g) A Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass holder shall surrender a , Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass to the Council at any time upon request if one of the following circumstances prevails.
 - (i) The , Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass ceases to be the owner or keeper of the relevant vehicle.
 - (ii) The Council have withdrawn the Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass.
 - (iii) The vehicle has been adapted so as not to comply with the conditions on application.
 - (iv) The Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass has been faded, mutilated, or defaced to leave it invalid.
 - (v) A duplicate Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass has been issued by the Council.
- h) The Council may by notice in writing withdraw a Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass and cause it to be invalid, if it appears to the Council that any of the issues listed in item (g) to this Article has occurred.
- i) Any applicant for a Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass returned to the Council before the valid from date will be entitled to a full refund.
- j) Any permit holder who surrenders a valid Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass to the Council after it has become active shall be entitled to a refund to the value of one twelfth of the value in relation to each remaining complete month left on the appropriate permit.
- k) The Council on receipt of a mutilated, defaced or faded Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass will issue a duplicate permit for the appropriate fee in Schedule 3.

- l) The Council will issue a duplicate Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass to any holder if it has been lost, destroyed or stolen and for the appropriate fee in Schedule 3.

9. Application for and issue of Season Ticket.

- a) Any person being the owner of a permitted vehicle to this Order may apply to the Council for a season ticket in respect to that vehicle under the conditions in Article 8 to this Order and under the terms and conditions relating to this season ticket and at a cost as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

10. Application for and issue of Resident Concessionary Season Ticket.

- b) Any person being the owner of a permitted vehicle to this Order and being a resident of may apply to the Council for a season ticket in respect to that vehicle under the conditions in Article 8 to this Order and under the terms and conditions relating to this season ticket and at a cost as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

11. Application for and issue of Southend Pass.

- a) Any person being the owner of a permitted vehicle may apply to the Council for a Southend Pass in respect to that vehicle under the conditions in Article 8 to this Order and under the terms and conditions relating to this Southend Pass and at a cost as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

12. Production of pay and display ticket or season ticket

- a) Where ticketless or advanced payment for season ticket has not been made, the holder of a physical season ticket shall display and produce the same on demand for inspection by a civil enforcement officer or authorised officer at any time whilst the vehicle is within a parking place.

13. Conduct in a parking place

- a) The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking space and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from that parking space.
- b) While a vehicle is in a parking space the driver of that vehicle shall not carry out or permit any work of cleaning washing construction maintenance or repair of the vehicle except such as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved from that parking place or such minor maintenance works or running repairs as may be necessary for the efficient driving of the vehicle.
- c) No person shall place upon or affix to a vehicle in any parking place any notice leaflet or other material of whatsoever nature unless he is an authorised officer or civil enforcement officer or the Council have previously given him consent in writing to do so.

14. Entrance to and exit from and parking in a parking place

- a) Where in a parking place, signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:-
- (i) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place; or
 - (ii) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place;
 - (iii) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit so indicated; or
 - (iv) in a direction other than that specified as the case may be;
 - (v) indicating the location and layout of the parking bays and spaces;
- no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven or to wait within the parking place/space other than in accordance with the signs and surface markings.
- b) The driver of any vehicle in a parking place shall comply with any instructions given by a civil enforcement officer or authorised officer as to the route to be followed within the parking place.

15. Suspension of parking places

- a) Any person duly authorised by the Council, may suspend the use of a parking place or parking space and place signs indicating the suspension whenever they consider such a suspension is reasonably necessary for:-
- (i) the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (ii) the purpose of any works adjacent to the parking place;
 - (iii) any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any part of the car park will be thronged or obstructed;
 - (iv) the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of a wedding or funeral or on other special occasions.
 - (v) the occasion that film crews require the place.
- b) No person shall cause a vehicle to stop or wait in any part of a parking place or space which has been suspended except if the vehicle is being used in an emergency by the fire brigade, ambulance service or police or a vehicle in the service of the Council undertaking statutory works to the street or if it displays a dispensation allowing the vehicle to park in that place or space.

16. Amendments to operational hours

- a) The Council may, notwithstanding the provision of this Order, by notice:
- (i) close any parking place, or part thereof, or;
 - (ii) extend the operating hours during which any parking place or part thereof, is available for use, or,
 - (iii) reduce the charging hours during which the charges in any parking place or part thereof are applicable.

17. Removal, or the alteration of the position of vehicles in a parking place.

- a) A civil enforcement officer in the case of an emergency or if they reasonably believe a vehicle is not lawfully parked in the parking place may:-
 - (iv) move or cause to be moved any such vehicle to any place they see fit; or
 - (v) remove or cause to be removed any such vehicle to a place of safe custody.

18. The use of Parking Permits, etc.

- a) The permitted use of a season ticket, valid Blue Badge in any car park is indicated in Schedule 1 to this Order and in line with the terms and conditions relevant to that Seafront Permit, Season Ticket and Southend Pass.

19. Revocation

- a) Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Southend-On-Sea (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (No. 2) Order 2021 is hereby revoked.
