

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)  
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING,  
LOADING AND UNLOADING (TTO26-27-06) ORDER 2025  
(CHAINGATE AVENUE)**

Notice is hereby given that Southend-on-Sea City Council has proposed to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering Chaingate Avenue from the junction of Newington Avenue for traffic, stopping, waiting, loading, unloading and parking.

The closure is scheduled to commence from 8am to 5pm on 24 March 2026 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The alternative route will be via Newington Avenue, Wickmead Close, Newington Gardens

The Order will come into effect on 24 March 2026 until 25 March 2026 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce for Carriageway maintenance.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
