Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Southend-on-Sea City Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”), in exercise of its powers under Sections 65(1), 81, 84, 85, 87, 122 and 124 (and parts I, II and IV of Schedule 9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, hereby gives notice that it proposes the following:

- To introduce a 20mph Speed Limit Zone on Meacham Way, Shoeburyness for its entire length and on Railtrack Way, Shoeburyness for its entire length.
- To replace Map Tile W28 Revision 0 from Schedule 2 of The 2025 Order with Map Tile W28 Revision 1 of this Order.
