

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING,
LOADING AND UNLOADING (TTO26-27-19) ORDER 2026
(LAUREL CLOSE)**

Notice is hereby given that Southend-on-Sea City Council has proposed to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from parking at the turning head at the rear of 21-22 Laurel Close adjacent to the retaining wall due to safety concerns. Prohibition of traffic, stopping, waiting, loading, unloading and parking in Laurel Close.

The closure is scheduled to commence from 3 April 2026 until 2 April 2027 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting at the turning head only.

The Order will come into effect on 3 April 2026 until 2 April 2027 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public until repair works are carried out to the retaining wall.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
