

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)  
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING,  
LOADING AND UNLOADING ORDER 2026  
ELM ROAD, TOWERFIELD ROAD & CAMPFIELD ROAD**

Notice is hereby given that Southend-on-Sea City Council intends, no less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from; -

1. Parking, stopping, waiting, loading & unloading on Elm Road from outside No10 to No38 & No15 to No45.
2. Parking, stopping, waiting, loading & unloading on Towerfield Road from its junction with Elm Road to Ness Road (A13) these will be done in phases.
3. Entering and exiting Campfield Road at its junction with Ness Road (A13)  
**This closure will only take place for two weeks within the dates below, and the dates for this will be advertised on site.**

The closure and suspensions are scheduled to commence from 08:00 on the 13<sup>th</sup> April 2026 until 17:00 on 18<sup>th</sup> May 2026 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The alternative route will be via Ness Road, Elm Road, High Street, Smith Street & Campfield Road and vice versa

The Order will come into effect on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2026 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst Gas Main replacement works take place.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
