SHAKEDOWN EVENT 2026

Notice is hereby given that to enable the 2026 Shakedown Event to take place on the Seafront the Council of Southend-on-Sea City intend to make an Order, the effect of which would be, to temporarily introduce the prohibitions listed in Table 1 at the locations listed in Table 1 of this Notice.

The Order would come into force at 5am on 6th April 2026 until 11:55pm or will continue in operation until the conclusion of the event, whichever is the earliest. The Order will continue for a maximum duration of 3 days.

The prohibitions would only have the effect at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of appropriate traffic signs and they would not apply to any vehicle or person connected with the event. Exemptions are provided in the Order for emergency vehicles, official event vehicles and pedestrians.

Any vehicle in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Order may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) and may be removed and relocated by a lifting vehicle.

Marine Parade	From its junction with Pier Hill to its junction with Southchurch Avenue	Traffic and suspension of parking
Hartington Road	From its junction with Seaway to its junction with Marine Parade	Traffic and parking
Pleasant Road	From outside No.5 to its junction with Marine Parade	Traffic and parking
Western Esplanade	From the Three Shells to Genting Casino turning to the East (Central reservation gap).	Closure of the southernmost lane and suspension of parking
Pier Hill	Entire length of the road	Traffic
Lucy Road	Entire length of the road	Suspension of one-way traffic and introduction of two-way traffic
Herbert Grove	From the turning head to its junction with Lucy Road	Suspension of one-way traffic and introduction of two-way traffic
Lucy Road	From outside No.30 to opposite the west side of the junction of Herbert Grove (south side of the road)	Parking Suspensions
Western Esplanade	Eastbound carriageway from Genting Casino to Pier Hill	Traffic and suspension of parking
