

PUBLIC NOTICE

Southend-on-Sea City Council gives notice that it proposes to install a build out under Section 3 and 4 of The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999.

The scheme proposes to amend the current road layout in Chichester Road, by:

- a) Installing a build out (Rediweld) bolt down keep right reflective bollard,
- b) Installing temporary ramps for pedestrians to enter the carriageway and safely pass the large tree at that location,
- c) Installing hatched markings to the south of the new bus layby
- d) Installing hatched markings to the north of the new bus layby,
- e) Reducing the road to a single northbound lane between York Road and Tylers Avenue.
