

PUBLIC NOTICE

Southend-on-Sea City Council gives notice that it proposes to install a traffic island under Section 3 and 4 of The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999.

It is proposed to install a traffic island on Royston Avenue at its junction with Eastern Avenue Service Road.

This installation of this traffic island is expected to prevent vehicles from cutting across the junction to exit Eastern Avenue Service Road onto Eastern Avenue enhancing pedestrian safety.
