

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, PARKING, WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING)
(TTO26-27-29) NOTICE 2026
(WOODSIDE)**

Notice is given that the Southend-on-Sea City Council under Section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, have imposed a temporary prohibition of vehicles. The effects of this Notice will be as follows:

Marlborough Highways Ltd will be carrying out resurfacing on Woodside from the junction of The Fairway to the junction of Thorndon Park Drive.

Whilst this Notice is in operation, the effect of this Notice will be to temporarily:
Ban vehicles from traffic and parking (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in Woodside from the junction of The Fairway to the junction of Thorndon Park Drive.

Diversion will be via: The Fairway, Thorndon Park Drive.

This Notice and prohibitions will come into effect on 18 May 2026 from 8am until 5pm daily and works are expected to be complete on 22 May 2026. However, this Notice may continue in force for a maximum of 5 days to allow for unexpected events/delays and possible remedial works. The restrictions within this Notice will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

The prohibitions described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a penalty charge notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004. The prohibitions will not apply to: anything done at the direction of a police officer in uniform, or a police community support officer (PCSO); any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; any official vehicle or person in connection with the works.
