

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA CITY COUNCIL  
(PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, PARKING, WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING)  
(TTN26-27-31) NOTICE 2026  
(Rayleigh Road Service Road)**

Notice is given that the Southend-on-Sea City Council under Section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, have imposed a temporary prohibition of vehicles. The effects of this Notice will be as follows:

Marlborough Highways will be carrying out carriageway works on Rayleigh Road Service Road, from its exit (adjacent to 167 Rayleigh Road) to the junction with Rayleigh Road. Access to Rayleigh Road Service Road will be maintained throughout the works.

Whilst this Notice is in operation, its effect will be to temporarily prohibit all vehicles from entering, stopping, or parking (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading) on Rayleigh Avenue Service Road, from the junction with Rayleigh Road Service Road to the junction with Rayleigh Road.

A diversion route will be in place via Rayleigh Road and as signed onsite.

**This Notice and prohibitions will come into effect on 27 May 2026 from 8am until 5pm daily and works are expected to be complete on 29 May 2026.** However, this Notice may continue in force for a maximum of 5 days to allow for unexpected events/delays and possible remedial works. The restrictions within this Notice will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

The prohibitions described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a penalty charge notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004. The prohibitions will not apply to: anything done at the direction of a police officer in uniform, or a police community support officer (PCSO); any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; any official vehicle or person in connection with the works.
