

**SOUTHEND-ON-SEA BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE ORDER 2026
INDEPENDENT FOOTPATH FROM WOODGRANGE CLOSE TO SOUTHCHURCH
BOULEVARD**

Notice is hereby given that Southend-on-Sea Borough Council has made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Effect of the order will be to temporarily close Independent Footpath from Woodgrange Close to Southchurch Boulevard.

The closure is scheduled to commence on 10th August 2026 to 2nd October 2026 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The alternative route will be via Woodgrange Drive, Lifstan Way, Southchurch Boulevard and vice versa

The Order will come into effect on 10th August 2026 and may continue in force for 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst Network Rail complete footway improvements works.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The prohibitions or restrictions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations And General Directions 2016

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction/prohibition imposed by this Notice may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice and removed under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004
